Thursday July 21st 1881
Light Trades from S.E. Course NW by N
The ship's crew set sail painting
with various small jobs Middle fine
weather Ends thick and raining from
N.W. No Obs

Friday July 22nd
Commenced with thick and raining from
N.W. to W Course NW by N took
in the large bottom stage cleaning
up the small plates and middle body
Ends with thick and raining from
W to NW wetting deck and commenced
to wash ship ready for painting
No Obs

Saturday July 23rd
Commenced with a heavy rain
storm from W Ends with light
air and calm Employed washing
ship
Lat-10-11 N
Long 36-26 W

Sunday July 24th
Commenced with light air and
calm Middle took a light breeze
from N by the wind to NW all
sail
Lat-10-11 N
Long 37-27 W

Monday July 25th
Commenced with light breeze
from N by the wind to NW
Ends with a heavy rain storm
from the Westward at midday
cleared off and clear out calm
Lat-10-42 N
Long 37-58 W

Ship cleaning the foreworks Ends calm
wetting Hole

Wednesday July 27th
Commenced with light air and calm
Employed at various jobs Middle beginning
wind Ends with light Trades and fine
weather from N.E. Course NW all
sail
Lat-10-42 N
Long 39-22 W

Thursday July 28th
Commenced with light S.E. Trades
from N.E. with fine weather Course
N.W. all sail Employed cleaning up
ready to paint Ends fine temp. voice
priming over the bare wood Course NW
all sail
Lat-12-20 N
Long 41-37 W

Friday July 29th
Commenced with light Trades and
fine weather Course NW by N all sail
Employed priming over the bare plates
Ends with fine weather from E.C. Course
N.W. by N all sail Employed
Painting Ship inside
Lat-14-01 N
Long 43-29 W

Saturday 30th
Breeze weather and light Trades from
E.C. Employed painting inside Course
N.W. by N all sail Ends fine Trades
N.E. Course NW by N all sail Painting
Lat-15-54 N
Long 45-27 W
