Remarks on Board Brig Selaron April with
Elmathan the Looking Master
Board on a Whaling voyage
Thursday April the 2th at 10 A M got
Anchor Way in Matapaia Harbor & made
this day the Winds S W

Friday April
First part strong Winds from S W
with single reef top sail at 5 P M numerous
hails being S E strong S W Middle part
light airs from the S W later part much the
same all hands sleep Lat 40° 41' Long 70° 30'

Saturday
April the 4th First part this twenty four hours commences
with strong Breeze from S W clearing S E Middle
part much the same tack to the W later part
Moderate through M. P. Lloyd in ships duty Lat 40° 20' Long 70° 25'

Sunday
April 5th
First part First strong Wind from the W with
hails at 4 P M tack to the S W Middle part calm
later part strong Breeze from the S W clearing S W
at 9 P M double reef top sail the winds S W with day
Lat 39° 15' Long 70° 55'

Monday
April 6th commencing with strong Winds from W
clearing to South at 1 P M tack to the S
Middle part the same at 1 A M tack
to the W steering W S W the Winds S W
later part moderate the Winds S
Lat 39° 15' Long 71° 56'

Tuesday
April 7th this day commences with Moderate Winds
from S E clearing S W by W with flying clouds &
showers of rain at 1 P M clearing S W by S Middle part strong
Breeze at 6 A M double reef top sail at 7 hoop in fore top sail
lost red men and came to the wind to east

Remarks on Board Brig Le Baron April 1840
Later part strong Winds Lat 36° 50' Long 72° 52' commencing
Wednesday

April 8th First part strong Winds from S E
heading to the E at 3 P M tack to the S W
Middle part moderate at 6 A M set double reef
top sails and stood to S W later part strong Winds
same 7 sails Lat 37° 04' Long 73° 40'

Thursday
April the 9th this day Begins with strong Breeze from
S E tack to the S E at 6 P M tack to the S
strong Winds and showers from Middle part the same
lost reef the main top sail spence and stay sail
later part the same Lat 36° 35' Long 74° 12'

Friday
April the 10th First part strong Wind from S E
heading S at 3 P M tack to the S E at 4 P M
set the fore sail Middle part Moderate at 12 tack
ship to S at 6 A M tack to S W the Wind
S E Lat 36° 30' Long 74°

Saturday
April 11th First part strong Breeze this twenty four hours
light Winds from S E at 3 P M tack to
the S W Middle part light airs from S E
heading S later part strong Breeze and rain
Lat 36° 30' Long 73° 50'

Sunday
April the 12th First part light squalls and rain heavy
squall from S E heading S Middle part calm ship
and heading W S W moderate Winds set double
reef top sails later part squally falling down
Monday Lat 37° 04' Long 73° 56'

April 13th this day Begins with strong Winds
from S heading W S W with showers of rain
at 3 P M tack to the S E at 6 P M tack
in the West Boat Middle part the Winds
hauled to the S heading W S W
strong Wind Lat 36° 42' Long 73° 50'
