May the 3rd First Part calm and heavy clouds at 4 P M light airs from S S E heading S S E Midle Part the same at 10 A M saw a Bluff Fish landed and toof some Latter Part light Winds from S S W as end Lat 36 40 Long 74 03 W

First Part light Winds from S S W May the 4th heading to the Westward and cloudy Midle Part strong Winds from S W heading to S S E Latter Part toof some the West Boat heading S S E Lat 36 34 Long 73 55 W

Tuesday

May the 5th First Part strong Winds and heavy sea at 4 P M the Winds shifted to West heading to S Midle Part the Winds from N heading S W at 6 P M saw Whales landed and skinned four and piled on toof them a long side as end this day
