

Remarks On Board Le Baron May 2 1840

Saturday First Port strong Wind from E & S E
May 9th Thick Weather and rain at 5 P M
Noon 4 Whales a long side to the White Port
and the last reef main top sail and four topmast stays
sail Midle Port moderate the Wind W & S W
and heavy heavy small from S E commencing
cutting Lat 36 30 N Long 73 22 West

Sunday First Port Mad'rat With a heavy small
May 10th at 5 P M finish cutting all hands
employed in clearing away the head at 8 finish
the Wind from S E & heading S W
Middle Port strong Wind from S E With
showers of rain at 10 M commencing
bailing at 10 P M cooled down on Observation
Lat 36 10 N Long 73 50

Monday First Port strong Wind from S E
May 11th at 1 P M took to W & S W
short sail Moderate Mad'rat at 6 P M
commencing bailing Latter Port Light air
from S E at 12 P M took to S E & S
Lat 35 58 N Long 74 02

Tuesday First Port Light air from the S
May 12th heading to the S E & S
remainder short sail Middle Port strong
Wind at 3 P M took to Westward
Latter Port moderate finished bailing & wind
Lat 36 05 N Long 73 15 W

Wednesday First Port Light Wind from W
May 13th heading to N spoke a Brig
bound to N York Middle Port the wind
the Wind baffling Latter Port staved down
oil Lat 36 38 N Long 73 19 W

Thursday First Port Light Wind
May 14th and am heading to the
S W Middle Latter Port calm so
ends this day Lat 36 28 Long 73 28

Friday First Port calm With 10 sails in
May 15th sight Middle Port Light
Wind from S E strong W the Wind
impelling Work at 10 P M S S W
heading W at 4 M saw 4 whales
latter Port Mad'rat Lat 36 47 Long 74 55

Saturday First Port Mad'rat the
May 16th Wind from S E at 10 got
sundries in 13 fathoms of Water
With run and tack to S E & S W
tack to Westward Middle Port strong
Wind from S at 1 M tacked to S E
Latter Port Mad'rat so ends this day
Lat 36 31 N Long 73 25 W

Sunday
May 17th First Port Mad'rat at 10 P M
tacked to W S W at 6 P M the ship
ships Sloop from N York Long 74 50 W
36 miles from Cape Henry Middle Port Mad'rat
heading to S E Latter Port calm Lat 36 Long 74 30

Monday First Port calm at 4 P M took
May 18th Light Wind from S heading
Westward saw 2 seals a head Mad'rat calm
at 10 M Light air from S E heading
to S and sailed in 20 fathoms at 10
to S W at 10 miles in sight Latter Port
Light Wind so ends this day
Lat 36 56 N Long 74 46 W
