

Remarks on Board the Brig Le Baron

Wednesday First Part strong Wind from and
May the 6th heavy sea from the N at 3 P M
commencing in evening at 7 finished cutting
stood to E under short sail Middle Part the
same Latter Part heavy sea so ended this day
Lat 35 53 N Long 74 20 W

Thursday First Part strong Wind and heavy
May the 7th small from the N heading
to W commencing to hail at 4 P M
to N E with light air Middle Part calm
Latter Part strong Wind from N so ended this day
Lat 35 45 N Longitude 73 50 W

Friday First Part Light Wind from N E
May the 8th heading N E 4 sails in sight
at 10 P M the Wind from N E Middle Part
the same at 1 M saw Whales heard
and struck storehouse 10 h's so ended this day
no Obles Lat 36 00 Long 74 00 W

Saturday First Part light Wind from
May the 9th by E heading S W by W shape
a brig 5 days from N yard at 5 P M
to E east saw 20 feathers of Water
Middle Part calm and passing clouds Latter
Part the same so ended this 24 hours
Lat 36 56 N Long 74 51 W

Sunday May 20th First Part light air from
E S E heading S 3 sails in sight Middle Part
Part tacked to N E Latter Part strong gales
from E by S at 8 P M tacked to S at
Main sail gills and try sail the Wind at 11
tack in sail so ended this day no Obles
Lat 37 00 Long 74 26 W

Remarks on Brig Le Baron May 21 1846

Thursday First Part strong Wind from S at E
May 21st at 2 P M Mad Mate saw a large school
of blue fish heading S W Middle Part
Mad Mate the Wind S W at 6 P M the
Wind W N W strong gales heading S W
a heavy sea Latter Part the same so ended this day
Lat 36 35 Long 73 44 W

Friday First Part strong gales from N W
May 22nd heading S W at 2 P M Mad Mate at
N W set foresail heading W S W Middle Part
Part Mad Mate at 12 M to N E at 7 P M
tack E Latter Part light Wind from N E so ended this
Lat 36 41 Long 73 31 W

Saturday May 23rd First Part light Wind from N heading
W N W 4 sails in sight Middle Part light from
the westward Wind heading S W Latter Part strong breeze
so ended this day Lat 36 42 Long 74 31 W

Sunday First Part strong breeze from S tack to eastward
May 24th at 4 P M spoke bark Degree with 200 lbs
at 9 P M tack to W Middle Part
Mad Mate Latter Part calm Lat 36 33 Long 74 1

Monday First Part light Wind from E S
May 25th heading to E S E with heavy small
and rain in company with the breeze Middle Part
Part strong Wind from E at 6 P M tack
to S E Latter Part the same Lat 36 35 Long 74 30 W

Tuesday First Part strong Wind from E S
May heading S E saw 200 lbs to Windward
26th Middle Part Moderate Latter Part
strong Wind from E heading N S
Lat 36 28 Long 74 36 W
