

Remarks on Board the Brig Le Baron 1840

Tuesday First Part strong Wind from
July 21st W. S. W. head ding S. W. by S
at 7 Laid reef top sails Middle Part
Light Wind at 7 same Whales hauled
and took 2 Lat 35 20 Long 45 20

Wednesday First Part calm took one Whale a
July 22nd Strong side and commence cutting
1 b.l.s of keel at 7 P.M. finished cutting at 6
same Whales laid to quick to wind
at 7 took in sail & sails in sight
the Wind S. W. heading W. S. W.
middle Part moderate at 5 P.M. same
Whales hauled and could not get on
at 7 commence heaving Later Part
the same Lat 35 50 Long 45 00

Thursday First Part Light winds from E. N. E.
July 23rd Head ding S. E at 7 P.M. took in
1 b.l.s of Middle Part Shows of rain at 9 A.M.
Finish heaving Later Part the same
Heading to N Lat 34 43 Long 44 30

Friday First Part Light Winds from W. N. W.
July 24th At 5 am spoke Bark arab of
Fair haven at 7 took in sail 3 sails
in sight Middle Part moderate
Steering W. N. W. at 6 A.M. saw
Whales in Co with the Bark arab
Lard and could not get on
Came on board heading S. W.
Saw Whales to the westward and
Steering from them Lat 34 45 00 Long 45

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Saturday
July 25th First Part Light air and calms at 1 P.M.
Lard and could not get on at 3 came
on board at 5 P.M. took to E. N. E. the
Wind from S. E. at 7 took in sail
Middle Part moderate at 3 A.M. took
to south at 5 A.M. saw a bark with
her cables half mast the scud
for her it was the Richard Henry
the captain was killed yesterday by
a Whalib Later part moderate
So ends this day Lat 34 46 Long 45 45

Sunday First Part Light air from the
July 26th S. S. E. Head ding to the E at
6 took in sail and took to S
Middle Part moderate at 5
A.M. made sail steering N. W.
at 10 steering N. 2 sails in sight
So ends this day Lat 34 56 Long 45 12

Monday
July 27th First part Light air from S. E.
Head ding at 7 P.M. took
in sail heading N. E. middle
Part moderate heading to N. at
A.M. took to S. E. Later part
Light air spoke Brig Chance with 300
b.l.s of keel Lat 35 00 Long 45 25

Tuesday First Part Light Wind
July 28th from S. S. E. heading E. at
4 P.M. took in sail Middle Part
Light from S. at 5 P.M. made sail
heading S. E. at 6 P.M. steered
at ends this Lat 35 22 Long 44 15
