Wednesday First Part Light airs from S.S.
July 29 Steaming S.E. by E at 7 P.M. took
and tack to Westward then 2^d Part
moderate at 5 A.M. made sail
 Latter Part squally and showers of rain
 Lat 35-29 N Long 43-5 W

Thursday First Part Light Winds from
July 30th S.W. heading S.E. by E
at 4 P.M. tacked to S.W.
tack in sail Middle Part
moderate at 5 P.M. made
sail Latter Part Light airs from
S.W. so ends this day
 Lat 35-4 N Long 44-25 W

Friday First Part light breeze S.W. by W
July 31st at 6 A.M. saw a great
flock of another house at 7 P.M. took
in sail 1 sail in sight Middle
Part light airs at 8 A.M. made
sail heading N.W. with squalls
and showers of rain Lat 35-06 Long
44-20

Saturday First Part light air from W
August 1st heading N.W. 1 sail in
sight Middle Part light air Latter
Part calm with showers no clouds

Sunday First Part calm at 4 P.M. Light
August 2nd air from E steaming W. by E
Part moderate Latter Part the same
 Lat 34-45 N Long 44-40 W

Monday First Part Light air from S.E.
August 3rd steaming N.W. 1 sail in sight at 5 A.M.
took in sail Middle Part moderate at 5 A.M. made sail
steaming N.W. Latter Part the same so ends this
day Lat 35-11 N Long 46-15 W

Tuesday First Part Light air from E.N.E.
August 4th at Steaming N.W. at 7 P.M. took in
sail heading to N. middle Part
Moderate at 5 A.M. calm saw whales
Lard and could not get on so ends
 Lat 35-17 N Long 46-30

Wednesday First Part Light air from N
August 5th Steaming to W at 4 P.M. saw a
Breach at 7 P.M. took in sail
Middle Part moderate at 5 A.M.
made sail Strong Breeze at 10 A.M.
Tacked to S.E. the wind E. at 1 P.M.
So ends this day Lat 35-18 Long 46-40

Thursday First Part Strong Winds heading S.E.
August 6th at 4 P.M. took to N. Light air
and showing of rain middle part
Moderate at 5 A.M. made sail
With a strong Breeze from E heading
N.E. Latter Part the same so
Ends this day Lat 35-38 Long 46-55

Friday First Part Strong Winds from
August 7th heading N.E. at 7 P.M. took in
sail Middle Part strong wind
at 5 A.M. made sail tacked to S
Latter Part the same so ends
 Lat 36-16 N Long 47-00 W

Saturday First Part Strong Winds
August 8th from E.S.E. heading S at 5
P.M. saw Whales leaved and shot
and at 8 took him a long side
Spoke Philip tale of maren no oil
Middle Part strong breeze from S.E. at 6
commence with Latter Part Light Winds
from E Lat 36-12 Long 46-40 W
