

Remarks on Board the Brig Te Raron 1840

Thursday First Part squalls and showers of rain and heavy squalls could not discharge Middle Part rain & at 10 A.M. Landed the letters so sent this Discharge 18 lbs oil

Friday First Part strong Wind from N. Oct 9 With heavy squall from N.E. at Moderate Latter Part the same at 11 A.M. saw letters of oil

Saturday First Part moderate at 2 P.M. Oct 10 the saw letters of oil that on shore Middle Part strong Wind at 4 P.M. the Wind shifted to S.E. Latter Part took 12 Casks of Water and one Watch on shore so sent on

Sunday First Part strong Winds from Oct 11 the S.E. and squalls of rain Wind & Middle Part the Wind of W. with rain Latter Part the same one Watch, one share on shore

Monday First Part Light Wind from Oct 12 the S.W. Middle Part moderate Latter Part took on Board 5 lbs of Water

Tuesday First Part calm took on Oct 13 the heard one pair of Potatoes and took the standard Anchor on the lower Middle Part moderate at 2 P.M. at 4 M. got under Way Latter Part

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Wednesday First Part moderate the Wind Oct 14 the Wind from the N. at 2 P.M. 1 lb Beef Wind West Middle Part hoisting calms 1 lb Beef Latter Part the Wind from N. Tugal having 5 Dist 6 miles

Thursday First Part moderate the Wind Oct 15 the from N. at 8 A.M. took in sail one sail in sight 4 miles S.W. of grassier Middle Part show of rain Latter Part light airs from N. grassier having 10 Dist 5 miles of seen

Friday First Part light Wind from Oct 16 the N. at 4 P.M. and showers of rain at 2 P.M. spoke Brig Lagrange with 100 lbs oil at 4 P.M. took in sail heading N. & Middle Part moderate at 7 A.M. made sail Latter Part the same Taraira having 10 Dist 10 miles

Saturday First Part light airs and hoisting Oct 17 the heading S.E. at 6 P.M. took in sail Middle Part strong breeze from E. & S. heading S.E. at 6 A.M. made sail Latter Part the same heading at Taraira having 10 Dist 10 miles sent a new top sail

Sunday First Part strong Wind from Oct 18 the E. N.E. heading S.E. at 2 P.M. took to 10 at 6 P.M. took in sail Middle Part strong Wind from S.E. Latter Part spoke Brig quito of Rochester with 250 lbs Taraira having 10 Dist 15 miles of S.E. & S.W.
