

Remarks On Board the Brig Le Baron 1840

Thursday First Part strong Winds from N.E.
Oct 29th heading N. N. W. at 6 P.M. took in
sail tack to S. Middle Part strong
gales from N.E. at 1 A.M. tack to
N. W. Latter Part strong Wind
Terceira bearing S. Dist 3 miles

Friday First Part strong Wind ^{was} here
Oct 30th the fore sail to repair at 9 P.M.
spoke the Brig Matapinett heading
N. W. Middle Part moderate Latter
Part the same Teco bearing N. Dist 5 m

Saturday First Part strong Wind N. W.
Oct the 31st at 2 P.M. lent the fore sail
at 3 P.M. tack to N. at 6 Tacked
S. W. clack reef the top sails
Middle Part same Latter Part moderate
Teco bearing N. Dist 5 miles

Sunday First Part strong Winds from
Nore the 1st N. N. E. capt got a shore at 8
P.M. came on Board and took in
sail heading S. Middle Part strong
Winds at 7 A.M. made sail at 11
A.M. double reef top sails between
Teco and S. gauge so ends the Day

Monday First Part strong Winds from N. W.
Nore the 2nd at 1 P.M. the Capt went on
shore at 5 P.M. came on Board
strong gales from N. W. Middle
Part the same at 7 A.M. last
Went on shore secured at this
Day capt and J. T. W. J. had
some Difficulty on shore Board
but not so much as their was on

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Tuesday First Part strong Winds from N. W.
Nore the 3rd at 5 P.M. the Boat came aboard
and steered out of the Passage heading
S. Middle Part strong gales from N. W.
starting N. E. Latter Part the same over
Terceira bearing N. Dist 3 miles

Wednesday First Part strong gales from N. W.
Nore 4th in company with the Matapinett
and Seyrongo middle Latter Part
light Winds and heavy swell from
N. Terceira bearing N. Dist 15 m

Thursday First Part strong Wind from
Nore the 5th at 6 P.M. took in sail
3 sails in sight Middle Part strong
from N. W. at 8 P.M. took in
the fore top sail and fore sail and
main top sail at 10 tack to N.
Latter Part the same Terceira
bearing S. W. Dist 30 miles

Friday First Part strong Winds from
Nore the 6th at N. W. heading N. by S. at 1
P.M. set the fore sail Middle
Part the same at 4 P.M. tack to
N. E. at 7 P.M. tack to S. W. at 10
P.M. tack to N. set the fore and
main top sail so ends this Day
Terceira bearing S. W. Dist 30 m

Saturday First Part strong Wind from N. W.
Nore 7th W. heading S. W. heavy swell from N.
at 6 P.M. took in sail Middle Part mod-
erate Latter Part calm Terceira
bearing N. W. Dist 10 miles over
