Sunday First Part strong gales from
Nore 6th W & W heading S at 3 P.M.
tack to N W at 5 P.M. took
to S with showers of rain & sails
in sight at 6 P.M. the Wind N W
and moderate Middle Part moderate
Latter Part light Wind and squalls
and rain Terceira leaving W Dist 5 m

Monday First Part strong Wind from W
Nore 9th heading N N W under short sail
with showers of rain Wind N W
heading N E moderate at 6 P.M.
made sail one sail in sight Latter Part
Terceira leaving W & W Dist 8 m

Tuesday First Part light airs from N
Nore 10th heading E bent a new top sail
at 6 P.M. took in sail heading E
with showers of rain Latter Part
strong Wind from S E & N E from
Terceira Dist 15 m so ends this

Wednesday First Part strong Wind from S E
Nore 11th steering S W at 6 P.M. came to
the Wind heading N at 7 P.M. tack
to S E middle Part moderate the Wind
S W Latter Part strong Wind N E of Terceira

Thursday First Part strong Wind from S W
Nore 12th at 6 P.M. took in sail heading S E
Middle Part the same the Wind falling
at 7 P.M. the Wind from N E & W
steering S Latter Part the same
Terceira leaving at Dist 40 miles

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Friday First Part strong Wind from N W
Nore 13th steering S at 4 P.M. steering
S by W with close reef top sails
Middle Part the same at 6 P.M.
made sail Latter Part moderate
and clear Weather second Lat 35 36

Long 26 40 W
Saturday First Part light airs and calm
Nore 14th steering S S W saw one
sail Middle Part strong Wind
from S W heading W Latter
Part Tacked to S S E Lat 35 9.15

Long 26 50
Sunday First Part strong Wind from
Nore 15th S W heading S S E with
close reef top sail with rising
clouds and showers of rain Middle
Part the same Latter Part clear
with strong Wind Lat 34 17 W

Long 26 40 West
Monday First Part strong Wind from
Nore 16th W & W heading S by E under
the 16th short sail with rising clouds
1 lbs Beef Middle Part the same at 6 P.M.
1 lbs Beef tack to W N W Latter Part heavy
squalls so ends this Day

Tuesday First Part strong gales from S W
Nore 17th at 5 P.M. tacked to S S W
under short sail Middle Part
moderate Latter Part the same
with heavy squalls from S E ends
N W so ends this Day of our Trip
Lat 33 24 Long 24 00 West
