

Remarks on Sat. Nov 19. 1830

This day begins with strong gales at N.E. & S.E. to squalls of rain cleared to the S.E. Under double reefed topsails. Middle part much the same latter part wind at East at which we were ship to stand to the northward. So ends this day Lat 35° 35' Long 53° 00' Dec 3. 1830

Remarks on Sat. Nov 20. 1830

This day begins with strong gales at East to squalls weather stood to the northward under double reefed topsails. Middle to latter part wind and weather the same.

So ends this day Lat 35° 12' Long 53° 10' Dec 5. 1830

Remarks on Sun. Nov 21. 1830

This day begins with strong breezes at S.E. & Cloudy weather. stood to the Eastward Under double reefed topsails. Middle to latter part the same. Saw a Brig leaving to the S.W. So ends day Lat 36° 26' Long 52° 10' Dec 6. 1830

Remarks on Mon. Nov 22. 1830

This day begins with strong gales at S.E. and Cloudy weather with a very bad sea. Middle part light winds. Latter part hard gales from the North bore the ship to under a close reefed mainsail to forenoon. So ends this day Lat 36° 18' Long 50° 34'

Remarks on Tu. Nov 23. 1830

This day begins with hard gales from the North to the under S.E. Mainsail to foresail heeled to the Eastward. Middle part more moderate made sail and cleared S.E. wind at N.W. Latter part light winds to pleasant weather with a great swell. Long by Chronometer 57.50 So ends this day Lat 36° 13' Long 48° 50' Dec 7. 1830

Remarks on W. Nov 24. 1830

This day begins with light winds at S.E. & N. and a great swell to pleasant weather. Middle to latter part strong gales at W. & N.W. Cloudy weather. cleared by N. to fresh. Lat 37° 28' Long 46° 02' Dec 8. 1830

Remarks on Thu. Nov 25. 1830

This day begins with strong gales at W. by N. and Cloudy weather. Steamed East. Middle part squally with much rain. Latter part light breezes at west with some rain. Set all sail to Steamed by S. So ends this day Lat 38° 01' Long 48° 21' Dec 9. 1830

Remarks on Fri. Nov 26. 1830

This day begins with strong breezes at West & Cloudy weather. Steamed S.E. with all sail. Middle to latter part the same. So ends this day Lat 38° 00' Long 39° 35' Dec 10. 1830

Remarks on Sat. Nov 27. 1830

This day begins with strong breezes at West and Cloudy weather. Steamed S.E. by E. with all sail. Middle part wind from all quarters much rain. Calms. Latter part fresh breezes at S.W. and Cloudy. Saw a Brig. So ends this day Lat 37° 19' Long 38° 52' Dec 11. 1830

Remarks on Sun. Nov 28. 1830

First part of this day brisk breezes at S.W. & Cloudy weather. Steamed S.E. by E. with all sail. Middle to latter part strong breezes at South and Cloudy weather. Steamed to the eastward Under double reefed topsails. So ends this day Lat 37° 36' Long 36° 25' Dec 12. 1830
