

Remarks on Mon Nov 29th 1830
 This day begins with strong breezes at
 S.W. & Cloudy weather by S.E. by E Wind.
 Double Reefed topsails Middle part very
 squally. took in fore & Mizzen topsails &
 set them again. Latter part strong breezes
 at S.W. & W. cleared S.E. by S.
 So Ends this day Lat 36°55' Long 36°00' Cr 26°00'

Remarks on Tue Nov 30th 1830
 First part strong breezes at W.S.W. cleared
 S.E. by S. Middle to latter part the same with
 squalls of rain. So Ends this day
 Lat 35°40' Long 35°00' Cr 25°10'

Remarks on Wed December 1st 1830
 This day begins with strong breezes at S.W.
 & flying Clouds. cleared S.E. by S.
 Middle to latter part squally weather. at 6 P.M.
 saw a ship steering N.W.
 So Ends this day Lat 34°10' Long 29°09' Cr 28°00'

Remarks on Th Dec 2nd 1830
 This day begins with quick breezes at West & Squalls
 of rain. cleared South Middle and latter part
 pleasant weather.
 So Ends this day Lat 32°18' Long 28°14' Cr 26°50'

Remarks on Fri Dec 3rd 1830
 First part light breezes at West and pleasant
 weather. cleared South Middle to latter part
 much the same.
 So Ends Lat 31°59' Long 27°55' Cr 26°16'

Remarks on Sat Dec 4th 1830
 This day begins with light airs at west & pleasant
 weather. cleared S.W. Middle part calm.
 Latter part light breezes at S.W. & pleasant
 weather. stood to the S.W. saw hills on
 So Ends this day Lat 31°19' Long 27°40' Cr 26°00'

Remarks on Sun Dec 5th 1830
 This day begins with light breezes at south
 & pleasant weather. stood to the westward
 with all sail. at 3 P.M. tacked to the Eastward.
 So Ends Sunday with fine weather & pleasant
 Lat 31°06' Long 27°50' Cr 26°36' Lunar Obs 28°05'

Remarks on Mon Dec 6th 1830
 This day begins with light breezes at S.S.W.
 and pleasant weather. cleared to the S.E. with
 all sail Middle part calm. Latter part
 light airs at S.W. & Cloudy weather.
 saw a ship to the N.W. So Ends this day
 Lat 30°44' Long 27°20' Cr 26°14'

Remarks on Tue Dec 7th 1830
 First part of this day light airs at S.W. and Cloudy
 weather. cleared to the S.E. Middle part calm.
 Latter part light airs at W.S.W. two sails in sight
 Lat 30°12' Long 26°48' Cr 25°43'

Remarks on Wed Dec 8th 1830
 This day begins with light airs at W.S.W. and
 pleasant weather. cleared South Middle to latter
 part much the same two sails in sight
 So Ends this day Lat 29°43' Long 26°40' Cr 25°38'
