

Remarks on 7th Dec 9-1830

This day begins with light airs from the North and pleasant weather. Cleared S.W. with all sail. Middle light breezes from the S.E. Latter part brisk breezes and light squalls of rain by S.W. by E. Long by lunar 25.43 So ends this day Lat 23.08 Long 26.5 Chr 26.01

Remarks on 8th Dec 10-1830

First part of this day brisk breezes at S.W. and squalls of rain. at 10 AM. tacked to the S.E. at 6 tacked to the S.W. Middle to latter part brisk breezes from the S.E. and squalls of rain. So ends this day Lat 26.55 Long 26.30 Chr 26.56

Remarks on 9th Dec 11-1830

This day begins with brisk breezes at S.E. and cloudy weather by S.W. by S. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw breeches to birdark run of one hour. Saw no more. Saw two sail. Long by lunar 27.40 So ends this day Lat 25.18 Long 27.03 Chr 27.29

Remarks on 10th Dec 12-1830

This day begins with brisk from the S.E. and pleasant weather. stood to the S.E. with all sail. Middle part much the same. Latter light airs tacked to the Eastward. Saw two sails. So ends this day Lat 23.58 Long 27.36 Chr 27.50

Remarks on 11th Dec 13-1830

This day begins with brisk breezes at S.E. to cloudy weather. stood to the Eastward. Middle to latter part much the same. Saw blackfish. lowered the boats. struck one & drewed the iron. So ends this day. Lat 24.20 Long 27.00

Remarks on 12th Dec 14-1830

This day begins with light airs at S.E. and pleasant weather. stood to the Eastward. Middle and latter part the same. saw two sails. So ends this day Lat 24.32 Long 26.04 Chr 26.00

Remarks on 13th Dec 15-1830

First part of this day light airs from the Southward & pleasant weather. stood to the Eastward. Middle to latter part light winds at S.E. & stood to the Southward with all sail. So ends the day Lat 23.43 Long 26.00 Chr 26.00

Remarks on 14th Dec 16-1830

This day begins with Calm & pleasant weather. Middle to latter part light breezes at S.E. Cleared to the S.W. with all sail. So ends this day Lat 22.36 Long 26.50 Chr 26.57

Remarks on 15th Dec 17-1830

This day begins with brisk breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather. stood to the S.W. at 6 P.M. wind S.E. & W. tacked to the S.E. Middle to latter part strong breezes & cloudy weather by S.E. Chr 26.38 So ends this day no obs. Lat 22.29 Long 26.50

Remarks on 16th Dec 18-1830

This day begins with strong breezes at South and cloudy weather. stood to the Eastward. Under single reefed topsails. Middle to latter part wind S.E. & W. and squally weather by S.E. Under single reefed topsails. So ends this day Lat 22.09 Long 25.09 Chr 26.53
