Remarks on Sun Dec 19-1830

This day begins with strong breezes at S.W. to Cloudy Hood to the S.W. with single reefed topsails. Middle part much the same. Latter part wind at S.W. & W. and more fresh. Moderate set all sail. Long by Chr 23-16. So Ends this day Lat 18-12 Long 23-12

Remarks on Mon Dec 20-1830

This day begins with fresh breezes at S.W. and Cloudy weather. by S.W. & W. with all sail. Middle part Breeze equally at 12 M. S. backed by ex. W. Latter part strong breezes at W. S. W. and pleasant weather. So Ends this day Lat 18-15 Long 23-20 Chr 23-00 Long by Lunar 23-59

Remarks on Tue Dec 21-1830

This day begins with brisk breezes at W. S. W. and pleasant weather. Hood to the S.W. two sail in sight. at 4 P.M. tacked to the S.W. Middle and latter part light breezes at West and pleasant weather. Long by Lunar 21-37. So Ends this day Lat 20-30 Long 23-00 Chr 22-56

Remarks on Wed Dec 22-1830

This day begins with calm & pleasant weather. Middle & latter part much the same. two brigs & one ship in sight. So Ends this day Lat 20-18 Long 23-04 Chr 22-51 good Lunar 21-40

Remarks on Th Dec 23-1830

This day begins with light airs at S.W. and pleasant weather. Steered S.W. Middle part brisk breezes at East Steered S.W. by S.W. with all sail. So Ends Lat 18-52 Long 23-35 Chr 23-16 Lunar 22-17

Remarks on Fri Dec 24-1830

This day begins with light airs at South and pleasant weather. Hood to the westward at a tack to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. tacked to westward. Spoke the British Bark ship Aboumoud of London 21 days out 80 barrels of gunpowder. Middle and latter part light airs at South and Cloudy. So Ends this day Lat 18-19 Long 23-58 Chr 23-38 from yesterday. Lunar 22-29

Remarks on Sat Dec 25-1830

This day begins with Calm and pleasant weather. Middle part much the same. Latter part Moderate breezes at S.W. and fine pleasant weather. Steered S.W. So Ends this day Lat 17-38 Long 24-10 Chr 24-21 from the

Remarks on Sun Dec 26-1830

This day begins with brisk breezes at S.W. and fine pleasant weather. Steered S.W. at 4 P.M. the Island of St. Nicholas bearing S.W. by S. 40 miles Dist. Middle and latter part light breezes at S.W. and fine weather. Steered South. at 12 noon the part of St. Nicholas bore N.W. by W. 25 miles Dist. So Ends Lat 16-18 Long 23-43

Remarks on Mon Dec 27-1830

This day begins with light breezes at East and fine weather. Steered South for St.ago. Middle and latter part wind & weather much the same. at 12 M. perceived the Iske of Noy's Shore East. at 4 P.M. bore N.W. by S. So Ends this day Lat 15-06
