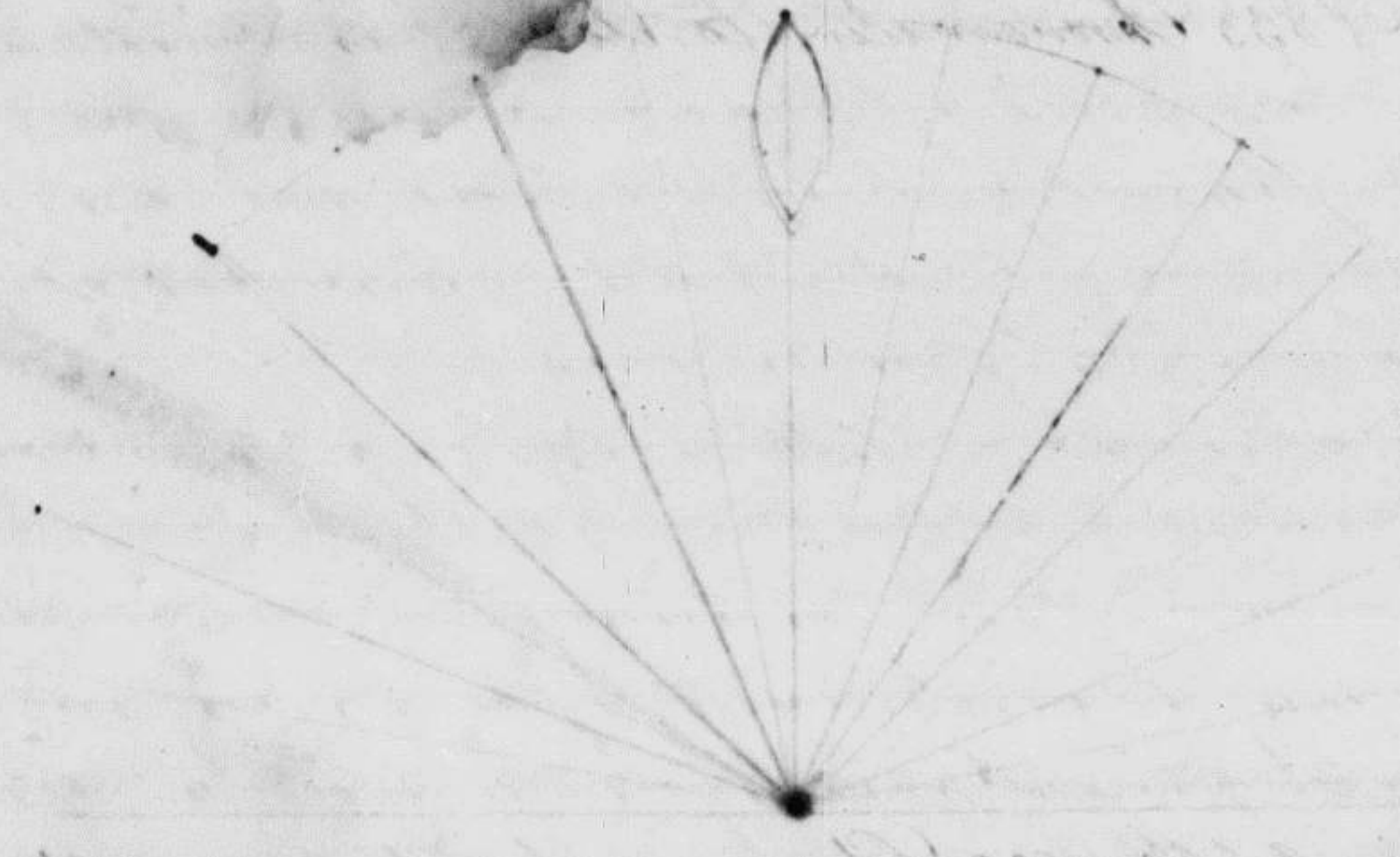

Remarks on Sat January 1st of 1831
This day begins with brisk breezes at East and cloudy weather cleared at Middle the same at 6th o'clock took in the standing sails wind S.E.
Latter part Moderate breezes at S.E. and good weather with some clouds
So Ends this day Lat 4th 55th Long 23rd 14th Ch 23.13

Remarks on Sun January 2nd 1831

First part of this day light breezes at S.E. and pleasant weather by 5th o'clock Minute part Calm - Latter part light breezes at S.W. by 5th o'clock saw porpoises to ends
Lat 4th 46th Long 23rd 50th Ch 23.45

Remarks on Mon January 3rd 1831

This day begins with light breezes at S.W. and cloudy weather is very warm Middle part light breezes from the north with torrents of rain & much thunder
Latter part light breezes at S.E. and some rain by 5th o'clock saw porpoises flying fish & Grampuses
So Ends this day Lat 4th 18th Long 23rd 50th Course S.W.

Remarks on Tue January 4th 1831

This day begins with light breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather by 5th o'clock at 6th o'clock to the Eastward wind S.E.W. at 8th o'clock to the Westward wind S.E. and squally weather Middle and Latter part light airs from the Southward and cloudy weather
So Ends this day Lat 3rd 55th Long 24th 34th
