Remarks on 13th January 1831

This day begins with strong breezes at 8 A.M. and good weather by 10 A.M. Middle and latter part wind and weather the same - Set up the rigging fore & aft - So ends this day Lat 16° 00' Long 32° 18' Chr 32° 03' at 10 A.M.

Remarks on 14th January 1831

First part brisk breezes at 8 A.M. and light squalls of rain by 10 A.M. Middle and latter part strong winds at 8 A.M. took in fore and main topgallant sails - So ends this day Lat 16° 01' Long 32° 22' Chr 32° 07'

Remarks on 15th January 1831

This day begins with strong breezes at 8 A.M. and fine weather. Steered S.W. by W. Middle part much the same. Latter part more moderate and very pleasant. So ends Saturday Lat 16° 09' Long 32° 50' Chronometer 32° 25'

Remarks on 16th January 1831

This day begins with brisk breezes at 8 A.M. and fine weather. Steered S.W. with all sail. Middle part much the same. Latter part moderate breezes at 8 A.M. by 10 A.M. Steered S.W. with all sail. So ends this day Lat 18° 31' Long 33° 30' Longitude by Chronometer at 9 A.M. 33° 12'

Remarks on 17th January 1831

This day begins with brisk breezes at 8 A.M. and pleasant weather. Steered S.W. with all sail. Middle and latter part wind and weather the same. Set up the rigging fore & aft. So ends this day. Saw a sail to the Eastward. The sun passed to the North of us. Subtracted the Declination. Lat 20° 59' Long 34° 35' Chr at 9 A.M. 33° 56'

Remarks on 18th January 1831

This day begins with brisk breezes at 8 A.M. and fine pleasant weather. Steered S.W. with all sail. Middle part wind and weather the same. Latter part brisk breezes at 8 A.M. Steered S.W. by S. So ends this day one sail in sight. Lat 23° 15' Long 35° 32' Chr 34° 44' at 10 A.M.

Remarks on 19th January 1831

First part brisk breezes at 8 A.M. and fine weather. Steered S.W. by S with all sail. All hands employed. Battling the rigging. Middle and latter part more moderate. So ends this day Lat 25° 16' Long 37° 01' Chr 35° 53' Long by Lunar 35° 46'

Remarks on 20th January 1831

This day begins with moderate breezes at 8 A.M. and fine weather. Steered S.W. Middle and latter part wind S.E. and very fine weather. So ends this day. Six studding sails set. Lat 26° 45' Long 38° 44' Chr 37° 20'
