

South of Cape Horn

Remarks on 21st January 21st 1831
This day begins with quick breezes at N.E.
and fine pleasant weather. Steered S.W.
Middle part the same. Latter part Cloudy
wind at N. both. So ends. Lat 28° 43' Long 39°
Chr from yesterday's obs 38° 49'

Remarks on 22nd January 22nd 1831
This day begins with brisk breezes from
the north and cloudy weather. Steered S.W.
Middle part wind N.W. with rain.
Latter wind the same and fine weather.
So ends this day. Lat 30° 13' Long 41° 26' Chr 40° 25'

Remarks on 23rd January 23rd 1831
This day begins with light breezes at N.E.
and fine weather. Steered S.W. with all sail
middle and latter part the same. Lunar at 3 P.M. 39° 56'
So ends. Lat 31° 16' Long 42° 27' Chr 41° 50'

Remarks on 24th January 24th 1831
This day begins with quick breezes at
N.E. by E. and pleasant weather.
Steered S.W. by S. Middle brisk breezes
and cloudy. Latter part strong breezes
at N. both. Thick weather.
So ends this day. Lat 33° 51' Long 44° 27'

Remarks on 25th January 25th 1831
This day begins with strong breezes from the
north & thick hazy weather. Steered S.W.
Middle and latter part strong gales at
N.E. by W. and squalls of rain.
at 4 P.M. took in all the studding sails & rye
for the first time from Lat 18° South to ends.
Made 2nd Dist Lat 35° 20' Long 47° 43' Chr 46° 11'

off Paraiti bank

Remarks on 26th January 26th 1831
First part strong breezes at N.W.
& thick weather. Steered S.W.
Middle part light breezes at S.W. by E.
Latter part light airs at S.W. & E.
A large swell from the S.W. by W. & W.
So ends this day. Lat 36° 28' Long 48° 06' Chr 48° 52'

Remarks on 27th January 27th 1831
This day begins with light airs at S.E.
and a great swell from the S.W. stood
to the westward. Middle & latter
part strong breezes at N.E. and thick
weather with some rain. Carried
away topmast studding sail boom &
yard. So ends this day.
Lat 37° 56' Long 48° 40' Chr 49° 58'

Remarks on 28th January 28th 1831
This day begins with strong gales
at N.E. by E. and thick weather. Steered
S.W. by S. under single reefed topsails
at 4 P.M. bore gales from the N.W.
Double reefed the topsails. took in the
main boat. Middle part more moderate
Lat single reefed topsails. Latter strong
gales. Double reefed the topsails.
So ends this day. Lat 39° 50' Long 50° 41' Chr 50° 54'

Remarks on 29th January 29th 1831
First part strong gales at N.W. and heavy squalls
of rain. Steered S.W. by S. under double main
and close reefed foretop sail and fore sail
and gencers. at 5 P.M. bore too with fore & main
gencers and foretop mast staysail.
Very hard gale at N.W. at W. Night had the
harriet at fore gencer. Latter part Wind S.W.
So ends. Lat 40° 45' Long 50° 30' Chr 50° 44'
