Remarks on Tue March 8th 1831

This day begins with strong gales at S. S. W.
to cloudy weather - cleared N. W. & N.
Middle part wind to weather much the same
Latter part light brisk breezes and cloudy
weather cleared N. E. W. till standing sails &c
to ends this day Lat 45° 36' Long 80° 00' Chr 8043

Remarks on W. March 9th 1831

This day begins with brisk breezes at S. S. W. and
cloudy weather - cleared N. E. W.
sent up foretopgallant yard got out waist boat
Middle and latter part strong breezes
at S. W. and cloudy weather cleared N. W.
saw one finback & caught one porpoise
to ends this day Lat 42° 42' Long 81° 00' Chr 8043

Remarks on Th. March 10th 1831

This day begins with strong breezes at S. W.
to cloudy weather cleared North
Middle and latter part strong breezes at S. W.
cleared North - to ends this day
Lat 39° 41' Long 79° 47' Chr 8023

Remarks on F. March 11th 1831

This day begins with strong breezes at South
cleared N. E. W. at 6 P.M. saw sperm whales
near the ship Lat 38° 50' Long 77° 55' - took in
tail & hove too - latter part cleared N. W.
to ends this day Lat 33° 13' Long 79° 00' Chr 8013

Coast of Chile

Remarks on Sat March 12th 1831

First part strong breezes at South to good weather
cleared N. W. & N. Middle to latter part wind to
weather much the same - saw two grasshoppers
to this day Lat 36° 00' Long 80° 00' Chr 8011

Remarks on Sun March 13th 1831

First part brisk breezes at S. S. E. to cloudy
weather - cleared N. W. & N. at 1 P.M. hauled
to the westward by the wind at 5 cleared N. W. & N.
latter part strong gales - to ends this day
Lat 33° 26' Long 80° 00' Chr 8024

Remarks on Mon March 14th 1831

This day begins with strong gales at S. E. and
cloudy weather cleared N. W. & N. with double
reefed topsails - at 2 P.M. saw the island
Majapure bearing west 25 miles dist.
cleared for the same at 6 shot in by the
North part of the Island and lost the wind
at 11 with much difficulty got by to lose
the breezes blowing very strong - this is a
bad place indeed flaws of wind striking on
shore and the swell doing the same
latter part stood to the Eastward - at 5 P.M.
saw Juan Fernandez bearing E. S. E.
saw a sail to windward standing for
Majapure - to ends this day Lat 33° 26' Long 79° 00'

Remarks on Tue March 15th 1831

First part strong gales at S. S. E. to N. W. brought
on cleared N. E. with double reefed topsails
Middle part the same latter part more
moderate let single reefed topsails
to ends this day thick cloudy weather
to ends Lat 32° 25' Long 78° 12'
