

Coast of Peru
Remarks on 1st April 1831
First part light winds at S.E.
In fine weather at 2 P.M. tacked to
the N.E. Middle & Latter part brisk
breezes and fine weather. Chased a
school of Whalers with five boats took them
to be Sperm whales. So Ends this day
Lat 19°32 Long 74°46

Remarks on 2nd April 1831
First part brisk breezes at S.E. and
fine weather stood to the Eastward
at 3 P.M. saw a brig tacking to the
Northward - at 6 tacked to the S.W.
the land in sight 12 leagues dist
Middle & Latter part wind & weather
much the same - saw blackfish
porpoises and small fish - So ends
Lat 19°34 Long 72°20

Remarks on 3rd April 1831
begins with brisk breezes at S.E.
In fine weather - stood to the westward
at 6 P.M. cleared N.W.
Middle & Latter part cleared N.W. wind
light - saw many blackfish
So Ends this day Lat 18°42 Long 73°17

Remarks on 4th April 1831
Begins with light winds at South
In fine weather cleared N.W. with all
sail Middle & Latter part much the
same - Employed mending a boat
Painting the ship & sheathing decks
Saw two finbacks So ends this day
Lat 17°48 Long 73°55

Coast of Peru
Remarks on 5th April 1831
First part light winds at N.E.
In Cloudy weather - cleared N.W.
Middle & Latter wind & weather
much the same saw blackfish &
many finbacks -
So Ends this day Lat 16°22 Long 74°55

Remarks on 6th April 1831
First part light breezes at S.E.
In fine weather cleared N.W.
Middle part cleared N.W. Latter part
cleared N.W. at 11 A.M. saw 1
Sperm whale - So Ends this day
No Obs Lat 15°30 the land 7 leagues dist

Remarks on 7th April 1831
First part light breezes at South
and fine weather - all the boats
in Chase of Sperm whales -
at 4 P.M. gave up the Chase
& took the boats up at 5 tacked
of Shore the breakers in sight -
at 2 A.M. tacked in Shore
Latter part brisk breezes at S.E.
Saw blackfish fin & humpback
So Ends no Obs Lat 15°30 the land 8

Remarks on 8th April 1831
First part brisk breezes at S.E.
Spoke the Sloop Lussanna and of
London Ferguson Master 8 months out
no skins - Middle & Latter part wind
& weather much the same - at 10
A.M. saw many Sperm whales put
off and got one - So ends no Obs Lat 15°30
the land 5 leagues dist
