Remarks on ~~Mon~~ April 25th 1831
First part brisk breezes at S.E. and fine
weather cleared S.E. point
Middle part by with the maintop sail
aback headed off shore Latter part
cleared North. Saw point of Paga
bearing S.E. 15 miles
So Ends no obs latter 6000

Remarks on ~~Tue~~ April 26th 1831
First part brisk breezes at S.E. and
fine weather cleared S.E. point
Dayta in sight - saw a brig
Middle part by too headed off shore
Latter part stood off shore with all
sail saw two humphacks
at the Meridian cleared S.E.
So Ends this day Lat 5^h 47' Long 6^h 82' 09"

Remarks on ~~Wed~~ April 27th 1831
First part brisk breezes at S.E.
and fine weather cleared S.E.
at 4 P.M. saw payta head
middle part by off shore Latter
part stood in for Payta
bent the cables S.E. So Ends this day

Remarks on ~~Thurs~~ April 28th 1831
First part quick breezes at S.E.
and fine weather at 2 P.M. came
too anchor at payta in 12 fathoms
water. At 4 P.M. had a visit from
the Capt of the port at 6 had a visit
from the Custom house ~~boat~~ Latter part
one watch a shore on liberty the rest
employed painting the ship
and combing the Howards hair -

on Board ship Leonidas ~~April 29th 1831~~
First part strong trade wind
and fine weather - Middle & latter
part much the same employed
in laundry duty - So Ends no potatoes

Remarks on ~~Friday~~ April 30th 1831
First part strong trade wind
and fine weather Middle Calm
Latter part strong winds
sent the boats to Duxone in pursuit
of potatoes gone 8 hours and got 8 bags
So Ends this day

Remarks on ~~Sat~~ April May 1st 1831
First part strong breezes and fine
weather Middle Calm Latter strong
winds got two cargoes potatoes done

Remarks on ~~Sunday~~ May 2nd 1831
First part strong trade wind
Middle Calm Latter light sea breezes
So Ends this day

Remarks on ~~Tu~~ May 3rd 1831
First part strong trades and
fine weather Middle & latter part
much the same - So Ends
