

Gallapagos Islands - Sun Jan 10th - 1831
First part strong trades & fine weather
Middle & latter part the same
Got off thirty Turpin -
So ends this day

Mon begins with strong trades and
fine weather. Middle & latter
13-1831 part wind & weather much
the same - got 11 or 13 turpin
So ends this day

Tue June First part brisk trades & fine
14th 1831 weather. Middle & latter part
much the same - at 4 o'clock got
underway. at 10 Calm of North
part of James Island. So ends this day
Chronometer at 8 o'clock 10 miles farther
West than it ought to be according to
James Island harbour is laid down

W. June First part light airs from the North & Cloudy
15th 1831 stood to the Eastward.
Middle & latter part Calm & light
Variable winds - strong current
setting to westward. At 9 o'clock M.
Saw sperm whales gave chase with
the boats 3 hours & lost sight of
them. So ends this day. between abington
& James Is

Thurs June Begins with light winds at East & E.
16th 1831 stood to the SE - Middle & latter
part light airs & Calm.
Saw finbacks - So ends this day
Lat 3.8 mi North Long 9000
I wish I could get a whale -

Gallapagos Islands
Fri June First part Calm -
17th 1831 Middle & latter part light breezes
from the Northward. & fine rain
here to the Eastward. Saw finbacks
So ends this day Lat 5.5 N. abington Is
at 12 miles left Gallapagos Islands - Bearing South
Sat Begins with moderate breezes at
June & Cloudy weather. stood to the
18-1831 Eastward with all sail -
Middle & latter part strong breezes at
S. E. & Cloudy weather. Saw sperm
So ends this day Lat 5.6 N Long 89.6 E

Sun June Commences with strong breezes at
19-1831 S. E. & Cloudy weather. stood to the
Eastward. Middle & latter part
strong wind. Single reefed the
topsails. Saw one bone shark.
So ends this day Lat 5.8 N Long 89.5 E

Mon June First part strong winds at S. E.
20th 1831 & Cloudy weather. stood to the East
Under single reefed topsails.
Middle part much the same -
Latter part more moderate - let all
sail. Saw nothing remarkable.
So ends this day Lat 6.1 N Long 89.5 E

Tue June First part brisk breezes at S. E. & E.
21-1831 weather. stood to the Eastward
Middle & latter part light airs
& Calm. Caught one turtle
So ends this day Lat 6.3 N Long 89.45 E
