

Coast of Peru
4 July 1831
Bregins with brisk breezes at 8 M.
In foggy weather stood to the S. E. with
all sails at 6 P.M. tacked to the west
Middle & Latter part wind & weather
much the same. Low happyish
to fishbacks
So Ends this day Lat 1° 18' S Long 82° 50'

5 July 1831
First part strong breezes at
South to some fog. stood to the
westward with all sail
Middle part the same at 4 P.M.
tacked to the Eastward
Saw fishbacks to End this day
Lat 1° 18' S Long 83° 00'

6 July 1831
First part brisk breezes at 8 M.
In some fog. stood to the Eastward
Middle & Latter part wind & weather
much the same at the Meridian
Saw a Bark to leeward
So Ends this day Lat 1° 18' S Long 82° 51'

7 July 1831
First part Moderate breezes at South
In thick weather stood to the East
with all sail. Middle & Latter
part wind & weather. Much the
same stood off 4 hours
So Ends with fog
Lat 1° 18' S Long 83° 13'

8 July 1831
First part Moderate breezes at 8 M.
In good weather stood to the S. E. with all sail
Middle & Latter part Much the
same. stood off shore half the night
So Ends this day Lat 2° 25' S
Long by Chron 84° 50'

9 July 1831
First part light breezes at 8 M. In cloudy
weather stood to the S. E. with all sail
Middle part Much the same stood
off shore 2 hours. Latter part brisk
breezes & good weather. at noon
saw the land bearing S. E.
So Ends this day Lat 3° 18' S Long 84° 00'

10 July 1831
First part brisk breezes at 8 M.
In fine weather stood to the S. E.
Middle part stood off shore. Latter
part stood in shore. Saw fishbacks
So Ends this day Lat 4° 15' S Long 84° 30'

11 July 1831
First part strong breezes at 8 M.
In good weather stood to the S. E.
tacked at 6 P.M. off shore the land
10 miles dist. Middle part the
same. Latter part more moderate
at 9 A.M. tacked in shore. ^{remained} lamp in
So Ends this day Lat 5° 16' S Long 85° 00'

12 July 1831
First part strong breezes at S. E.
In good weather stood in shore
at 4 tacked off. saw a large ship to
westward standing in shore
at 12 M. tacked in shore. Middle
part Moderate. Latter part strong
breezes. saw many hump back
So Ends this day Lat 6° 24' S Long 85° 45'

13 July 1831
First part strong breezes at South to fine weather
stood in shore with all sail at 4 tacked off saw
killers at 7 A.M. tacked in shore. Latter part
strong breezes stood to the Eastward with all sail
at 11 A.M. tacked off shore the land 10 miles dist.
So Ends this day Lat 6° 45' S Long at 70° 45' 86° 25'
