

Coast of Peru - Sept 4

15<sup>th</sup> July First part strong breezes at South  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 & Clear - Flood off shore with all sail  
Middle & latter part much fog  
saw finbacks & blackfish  
So ends this day Lat 5° 19' Long 83° 19'

16<sup>th</sup> July First part strong breezes at S.E.  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 & Cloudy weather flood to the  
westward. Middle by too under  
Main top sail & fore sail & runners  
Latter part strong breezes at S.E.  
Set the top sails & flood to the S.W.  
saw many blackfish & some finbacks  
So ends this day Lat 5° 50' Long 84° 15'

17<sup>th</sup> July First part strong breezes at S.E. & Cloudy  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 Flood to the S.W. with all sail excepting  
top gallent sails - Middle & latter part  
strong breezes at S.E. flood to the east  
with single reefed top sails - at the  
noon looked through eyes saw a sperm whale  
So ends this day Lat 5° 45' Long 84° 38'

18<sup>th</sup> July First part strong breezes at S.E.  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 & Rough flood to the S.W. Under single  
reefed top sails Middle part flood to the  
Eastward Under double reefed top sails  
Latter part set single reefs saw blackfish  
So ends this day Lat 5° 47' Long by Chr 84° 00'

19<sup>th</sup> July First part strong breezes at S.E. & Cloudy  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 Flood to the Eastward - Middle & latter part  
much the same saw a ship to leeward 2 points  
So ends this day Lat 5° 36' Long 82° 50'

16<sup>th</sup> July Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & S.  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 Cloudy weather flood to the Eastward  
with all sail - Middle part much the same  
flood off shore four hours - latter part  
some fog to fine rain - saw hump backs  
So ends this day Lat 5° 20' Long 84° 50'

17<sup>th</sup> July Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & Cloudy  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 weather flood in shore - Middle part  
by too heavy off shore - at 6 P.M. sail from  
Punta - at 8 A.M. spoke ship  
Sann Alexander of Rio de Janeiro  
1200.33 months out - told him of fly  
gib boom - latter part cleared  
North - saw fin & hump backs  
So ends this day Lat 5° 43' Long 84° 12'

18<sup>th</sup> July Begins with moderate breezes at S.E.  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 & fine weather - cleared S.E.  
Middle part some rain headed off  
shore - latter part cleared S.E.  
saw hump & fin backs the same in sight  
So ends this day Lat 6° 50' Long 84° 30'

19<sup>th</sup> July First part brisk breezes at South  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 cleared S.E. & S. - Middle & latter  
part strong breezes to fog flood off  
shore with all sail saw finbacks  
So ends this day Lat 6° 21' Long 82° 25'

20<sup>th</sup> July Begins with brisk breezes at South to some fog  
18<sup>th</sup> 1831 cleared next - Middle & latter part  
much the same flood off shore -  
at 11 A.M. saw a large shoal of whales  
part of 16 got one small one the rest  
So ends this day Lat 6° 00' Long 84° 00'
