Thurs July 24-1831 Begins with fresh breezes at S.E. & some fog. Put out the whole of the main sail at 7 P.M. tacked in shore. Middle & Latter part wind & weather the same at 4 P.M. commenced hauling at 9 tacked to the westward. So ends this day Lat 34° 8' Long 84° 00'

Fri July 25-1831 First part fresh breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the S.W. Middle part the same at 8 P.M. finished hauling. Latter part Stead to the Eastward. Saw finbacks. So ends this day Lat 34° 9' Long 85° 00'

Sat July 26-1831 First part strong breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the Eastward all hands employed tearing down & building up the Cabos. Middle part much the same at 6 P.M. tacked of shore. Latter part more moderate. Set all sail. Saw blackfish & finbacks. So ends this day Lat 34° 5' Long 84° 30'

Sun July 27-1831 First part fresh breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the S.W. with all sail at 6 P.M. tacked to the Eastward. Middle & Latter part strong breezes. Saw finbacks & blackfish. So ends this day Lat 34° 56' Long 84° 40'

Henry Cleveland Ship Annals
Thurs July 25-1831 Begins with moderate breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the Eastward with all sail. At 10 tacked to westward. Under single reefed topsails. Latter part strong breezes. At 11 P.M. Spoke Ship American 11 months out 300 barrels. So ends this day Lat 34° 16' Long 84° 20'

Fri July 26-1831 First part strong winds at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the westward. Middle & Latter part squally weather. At 6 P.M. tacked to the Eastward. Saw nothing remarkable. So ends this day Lat 34° 27' Long 85° 00'

Sat July 27-1831 First part strong breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the Eastward. Under short sail. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate. Set all sail. Saw nothing remarkable. So ends this day Lat 34° 43' Long 84° 00'

Sun July 28-1831 Begins with light breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the Eastward. Got out the new fly jib boom. Middle & Latter part fresh breezes at S.E. & cloudy weather. Stead to the S.W. Saw nothing remarkable. So ends this day Lat 34° 49' Long 84° 20'
