

Coast of Peru. Shift by
27 July Regins with brisk breezes at S.E.
28 July 1831 In Cloudy weather stood to the N.E.
Middle part strong winds
by S.W. at 9 A.M. Ship American
Set Collours for whales at 10 Saw
them going to seaward
at 12 saw more to seaward
gave chase but could not strike
So Ends this day Lat 5°31 Long 85°15

29 July Regins with strong winds at S.E.
30 July 1831 In Cloudy weather Chasing whales
but could not come up with them
at 3 tacked to the westward
at 10 P.M. tacked to the Eastward
Middle part strong breezes
at 6 tacked to the westward
Latter part brisk breezes in fine weather
So Ends this day Lat 5°47 Long 86°12

31 July Regins with brisk breezes at S.E.
1 Aug 1831 In fine weather stood to the westward
with all sail. Middle part light
winds at 4 A.M. tacked to the
N.E. Latter part strong winds
lost sight of ship
at 10 saw fin backs of Booby's
So Ends this day Lat 6°39 Long 87°00

2 Aug Regins with strong breezes at S.E.
3 Aug 1831 In Cloudy weather
stood to the N.E.
Middle part the same - saw ships
American & Victory - the American
got a whale - we chased all
the latter part of this day
So Ends this day Lat 5°57 Long 86°00

Henry Cleveland ship Leonidas
1 Aug Regins with strong winds at S.E.
2 Aug 1831 In Cloudy weather stood
from N.W. to N.E. in chase
of a sperm whale with the boats
at half past five P.M. gave up
the chase & took the boats up
to stand off shore at 2 A.M. tacked
in shore Latter part good weather
but cloudy - saw 1 ship to windward
Manneding & expect with whales
Ship American in sight
So Ends this day Lat 5°00 Long 85°45

3 Aug Regins with brisk breezes at S.E.
4 Aug 1831 In Cloudy weather stood to the S.E.
Middle part light winds stood to the S.W.
Latter part good breezes stood to the S.E.
filled Low fin backs of blackfish
water So Ends this day Lat 3°33 Long 85°10

5 Aug Regins with brisk breezes at S.E.
6 Aug 1831 In good weather stood to the N.E. with
all sail at 4 P.M. tacked to the N.W.
Middle part wind & weather
much the same at 10 A.M. tacked
to the S.W. saw fin backs
So Ends this day Lat 6°15 Long 86°05

7 Aug Regins with brisk breezes at S.E. in fine
8 Aug 1831 weather stood to the N.E. with all
sail at 4 P.M. passed ship Victory
at 10 tacked to the westward
at 10 A.M. passed ship American
Middle part wind & weather
much the same - saw plenty of birds
So Ends this day Lat 6°28 Long 85°40
