

Coast of Peru Sept 1st
Aug 1831 Regins with brisk breezes at S.E. 1/2
Cloudy weather stood to the East
at 5 P.M. spoke Boat President
Middle part stood off shore
Latter part strong breezes to Cloudy
stood to the Eastward
So ends this day Lat 4° 14' Long 81° 50'

Wed 1st
Aug 1831 Regins with strong breezes at South
Cloudy weather stood to the
Eastward President in Company
at 10 P.M. looked to the westward
Middle part some fog
Latter part brisk breezes to Cloudy
weather stood to the S.W. with all sail
Saw fin backs & small birds
So ends this day Lat 4° 14' Long 82° 00'

Th 1st
Sept 1831 First part brisk breezes at S.E. 1/2
Cloudy weather stood to the westward
with all sail back President off the quarter
one ship to windward standing in there
Middle part stood off under short sail
Latter part stood N.E. 1/2 E. with
all sail. Saw fin backs
So ends this day Lat 4° 35' Long 82° 00'

F 2nd
Sept 1831 First part brisk breezes at S.E. 1/2 good
weather. Steered S.E. 1/2 E. with all sail
Middle part headed to the East
under short sail at 7 P.M. saw
Sperm whales they perceived the boats
So went off took up the boats & made
President sail saw more whales put off & got
Minerva one. So took him to the ship & then
in sight to Quas Lat 4° 00' Long 82° 00'

Henry Cleveland ship Dominica
Lat 32 Regins with light breezes to Cloudy
Sept 1831 weather. But in the whale I stood to
the Eastward half the night at
8 A.M. began to sail at 8 Steered
off N.E. 1/2 E. at 10 saw ship Minerva
choosing water at 11 looked to the
Eastward. Soon saw whales off weather
low. Saw many humpbacks
So ends Lat 3° 40' Long 82° 00' 1/2

Sun 4th
Sept 1831 Regins with brisk breezes at South
In fore in other saw many sperm
whales at 3 P.M. put off & got one
at 5 got him to the ship at 6 pass
finished cutting & started in fire
again. Middle & latter part moderate
breezes with thick weather
Several ships in sight. Some humpbacks
So ends this day Lat 3° 30' Long 82° 30'

M 5th
Sept 1831 Regins with brisk breezes at South to the
weather stood to the Eastward
Saw two ships. Tacked off at 10 P.M.
In in at 2 A.M. Latter part strong breezes
Saw many fin backs & small black fish
So ends this day Lat 3° 30' Long 81° 50'

Tu 6th
Sept 1831 Regins with strong breezes at South to
Cloudy weather stood to the westward
with single reefed topsails at 6 P.M.
passed a ship. Middle part more weather
at 2 A.M. tacked to the eastward. Latter part
strong breezes to some fog. Saw fin backs
So ends this day Lat 3° 30' Long 82° 30'
this day **KILLED** 10 **Thompson** the Catable
part weighed 9 1/2 lb to 1 1/2
