

Coast of Peru

Th 18<sup>th</sup> Begins with strong winds & some fog  
Sept 1831 Hood in shore employed boiling  
Middle to latter part good weather  
Hood to the westward at 10 o'clock finished  
Boiling saw nothing remarkable  
So ends this day Lat 2° 15' Long 82° 45' W

Fri 19<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds & good weather  
Sept 1831 Hood in shore Middle to latter part  
much the same Hood in shore  
saw nothing remarkable  
finished blowing down the hill  
So ends Lat 2° 15' Long 82° 00' W

Sun 18 Begins with brisk breezes at South  
Sept 1831 Good weather Hood in shore -  
Middle part moderate breezes Hood  
off 4 hours latter Hood to the S.E.  
Wind S.W. good weather  
saw one finback some Grampases  
So ends this day Lat 2° 47' Long 82° 00' W

Mon 19<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.W. to S.  
Sept 1831 Fine weather Hood to the S.E. with all  
sail at 9 P.M. tacked to the westward  
Middle to latter part wind & weather  
much the same at 4 A.M. saw sperm  
whales put off but could not strike  
at 11 put off again & fastened with  
two boats to ensue Hood Lat 3° 05' Long 82° 30' W

Tue 20<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes & cloudy weather  
Sept 1831 at 10 P.M. got 4 whales to the ship & began  
cutting - Middle to latter part strong  
breezes & rough weather cut in the  
whales to make sail saw breaches a few  
So ends this day Lat 3° 09' Long 82° 30' W

by Henry Cleveland ship Leeward  
Th 21<sup>st</sup> Begins with strong breezes at South  
Sept 1831 Cloudy weather Hood to the  
Eastward with short sail to Commence  
boiling Middle part Hood off shore  
latter part Hood in saw one fin back  
So ends Lat 2° 09' Long 82° 00' W

Wed 22<sup>nd</sup> Begins with light winds at S.W.  
Sept 1831 Hood away weather Hood to the east  
at 2 P.M. finished boiling wind to the  
same time tacked to the west  
Middle to latter part brisk breezes  
saw hump backs  
So ends this day Lat 2° 33' Long 82° 30' W

Th 23<sup>rd</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.W. to S.E.  
Sept 1831 weather Hood to the west  
at 4 P.M. tacked to the East  
Middle to latter part wind & weather the same  
aged 22 years saw finbacks & blackfish the Rejs & C  
all hands employed in shifting fresh water  
fixed some broken boxes  
So ends this day Lat 2° 40' Long 81° 30' W

Fri 24<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at South  
Sept 1831 Cloudy weather Hood in shore  
Middle to latter part Hood off  
saw nothing remarkable  
So ends Lat 2° 30' Long 82° 30' W

Sat 25<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at South with some fog  
Sept 1831 Hood off shore at 10 P.M. tacked in shore  
Middle to latter part wind & weather  
the same saw nothing remarkable

So ends this day.  
Lat 2° 45' South Long 82° 25' West
