 in 10 fathoms water - lying there ship
 at anchor. Wier 500 magnolia Worth 600
 Good return berry. Courier Barnard

 breezes - Employed painting the ship
 To ends

 Received the Visit from the Capt
 the Custom house to Capt of the port
 To ends all ready for sea

M. 17th Begins with strong trades at 11 PM got underway
 Oct 1831st stood off by the wind - Middle & latter
 part some fog - stood off by the wind
 To ends this day Lat 50.8 Long 82.15
