

Coast of Peru kept by Henry
Nov 18th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E.
Oct 1831 Good weather stood off shore by
the wind - Middle & Latter part
the same at 11 o'clock began to see fin backs
So ends this day Lat 6° 45' Long 83° 40'

Nov 19th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & H.
Oct 1831 Cloudy weather. stood off shore
by the wind - with all sail
Middle & Latter part wind & weather
the same - saw fin backs & blackfish
So ends this day Lat 6° 45' Long 83° 40'

Nov 20th Begins with brisk trades & cloudy
Oct 1831 weather stood off shore by the wind
Middle part the same - Latter part
fine pleasant weather - saw blackfish
So ends Lat 9° 29' Long by Chron 81° 40'

Nov 21st Begins with brisk breezes at E.S. & H.
Oct 1831 fine pleasant weather - stood to the
South - Middle part by South & H. & E.
at 7 A.M. tacked to the S.E.
at 8 saw sperm whales put off
with all the boats -
So ends this day Lat 9° 40' Long 87° 40'

Nov 22d Begins with moderate breezes at
Oct 1831 S.E. & H. and fine pleasant weather
saw 8 or 10 large whales at half past
4 P.M. got two of them alongside
Middle & Latter part wind & weather
the same - at 5 o'clock commenced
cutting got in one body & cut off
both heads -
So ends this day Lat 9° 40' Long 88° 10'

Cleveland - Ship Leonidas
Jan 23 Begins with moderate breezes at
Oct 1831 E.S. & H. fine weather Employed
cutting at 1 P.M. saw three or four
large whales - at 2 gave chase with
the boats and got one to one boat
alone - at 4 P.M. got him alongside
- Cut in the body of two whales
to one junk - Middle & Latter
part wind & weather the same
Employed boiling & cutting
began boiling at 6 P.M.
saw a bark to leeward -
to sperm whales -
So ends Lat 9° 54' Long 88° 30'

Nov 24 Begins with light winds & fine
Oct 1831 weather employed cutting & boiling
Middle part some light squalls -
Latter part fine weather - spoke ship
Holland of New Bedford 10 months
but 1600 barrels sperm oil -
So ends Lat 9° 50' Long 89° 00'

Nov 25th Begins with brisk breezes at E.S. & H.
Oct 1831 fine weather at 3 P.M. finished cutting
Employed boiling & H.C. - Middle & Latter
part wind & weather the same
So ends this day Lat 9° 29' Long 89° 10'

Nov 26 Begins with brisk breezes & fine weather
Oct 1831 stood to the S.E. with a main top sail
& fore sail. Employed boiling & H.C.
Middle & Latter part light squalls
of rain - at 4 o'clock finished boiling
at 9 got washed off & began to break
out the hold - ends Lat 9° 46' Long 89° 30'
