

Coast of Peru Kept by Henry Cleveland

Th 27th Begins with strong breezes at 8 A.M.

Oct 1831 B Cloudy weather - stood to the north
Employed stowing down bil -
Middle & Latter part strong breezes
B. Squally weather - saw 10 birds to
windward - Ends Lat 11° 02' Long 90° 00'

Th 28th Begins strong breezes at 8 A.M. B. Cloudy
Oct 1831 weather - stood to the south -

at 3 P.M. finished stowing down bil
Middle & Latter part wind & B
weather the same -
at 10 A.M. spoke ship Courier
Barnard all full bound home
Spoke bark Esq. Whitten bound
home wanting 50 barrels oil
So ends Lat 10° 35' Long 90° 00'

Sat 29th Begins with strong breezes at 8 A.M. B. S. E.
Oct 1831 B. good weather - stood to the south
with all sail - at 10 P.M. tacked

to the N. E. - Under single reefed
topsails - Middle & Latter part
wind & weather much the same
Saw nothing remarkable -
so ends this day Lat 10° 25' Long 89° 12'

Sun 30th Begins with brisk breezes at
Oct 1831 8 A.M. B. fine weather - stood to
the S. E. with all sail -

Middle & Latter part the same
at 4 P.M. saw ship John Howland
cutting a large whale -
So ends this day Lat 9° 15' Long 88° 20'

Ship Leonidas

Th Oct 31st 1831 Begins with brisk breezes at 8 A.M.
and good weather - at 4 P.M.

Spoke ship John Howland 1500 tons
Next morning saw them - got
a large whale -
Middle & Latter part strong
breezes at 2 & 4 P.M. tacked to the
south -
So ends this day Lat 9° 00' Long 88° 00'

Mon Nov 1st 1831 Begins with brisk breezes at
8 A.M. B. Cloudy weather - stood

to the southward at 3 P.M. saw
a large sperm whale going fast
to windward gave chase with
the boats 2 1/2 hours & gave
it up & took the boats up -
Middle & Latter part Moderate
stood to the south - saw Rooby's
Man of war hawk & flyfish -
So ends this day Lat 10° 10' Long 88° 44'

Th Nov 2nd 1831 Begins with Moderate breezes at 8 A.M.
B. fine weather - stood to S. E.

with all sail - Middle part strong
breezes - Latter part Moderate -
stood to the south - at 4 P.M. Howland
So ends this day Lat 10° 00' Long 88° 15'

Th Nov 3rd 1831 Begins with brisk breezes at 8 A.M. B. fine weather - stood
to the north with all sail - Middle part

by too Latter part B. area. W. 1/2
at the Meridian - saw sperm
whales - saw a ship -
So ends Lat 9° 29' Long 88° 15'
