Sat 10th Begins with brisk breezes at E. S. S.
Dec 1831 In fine weather. stood to the North with
all sail - Middle & latter part
strong breezes & Cloudy
So ends this day Lat 10th Long 88⁰⁰

Sun 11th Begins with strong breezes at E. S. E.
Dec 1831 Cloudy weather - Middle & latter
strong breezes at S. E. & very rough
at 8 o'clock. M. saw sperm whales
put off boats but could not strike
So ends this day Lat 9⁴⁵ Long 88²⁵

Mo 12th Begins with strong winds & rough
Dec 1831 weather. struck one whale &
drewed from him
Middle & latter part good weather
at 4 o'clock. M. saw sperm whales
and got one 30 or 40 barrel whale
So ends this day Lat 9¹⁹ Long 87³⁰

Tu 13th Begins with brisk breezes & fine
Dec 1831 weather at 4 P.M. finished cutting
at 5 - saw more whales to windward
Middle & latter part wind and weather
much the same at 7 P.M. began to
hoist - at 6 o'clock M. saw many whales put
off & got one 40 or 50 barrel whale
So ends this day Lat 9¹⁵ Long 87³⁰

took Mr. Cooper to eat in the Cabin

Cleveland - Ship Leonidas

W 14th Begins with brisk breezes & fine
Dec 1831 weather at 4 P.M. finished cutting
at 7 began to hoist - Middle & latter
part wind & weather much the same
So ends this day Lat 9¹⁴ Long 87⁴⁰

Th 15th Begins with brisk breezes at S. E. & E.
Dec 1831 In good weather - 3 men sick & off duty
Middle and latter part wind and weather
the same saw blackfish & body at 2 o'clock
So ends this day Lat 9¹⁶ Long 87⁴⁰

F 16th Begins with brisk breezes at S. E. and
Dec 1831 good weather. cleared S. E.
Middle & latter part wind and weather
the same - latter part run off 7 P.M.
saw blackfish & one finback
So ends this day Lat 9³⁷ Long 88⁰⁰

Sat 17th Begins with brisk breezes & fine
Dec 1831 weather cleared W. S. W.
Middle & latter part the same. stood to the
South saw nothing remarkable
So ends this day Lat 10¹⁸ Long 87⁴⁰

Sun 18th Begins with light winds & very pleasant
Dec 1831 Middle & latter part wind and weather the
same - at 4 P.M. tacked to the north
saw blackfish - two body - one was hump
So ends this day Lat 10²² Long 88⁴⁶

Mo 19th Begins with pleasant breezes & fine weather - stood
Dec 1831 to the North with all sail - Middle & latter part
wind & weather the same - at 9 o'clock M. saw
sperm whales - put off & got one 30 or 40 barrel
So ends this day Lat 9²⁰ Long 88⁰⁰
