

Coast of Peru kept by Henry Cleveland  
Dec 20<sup>th</sup> Begins with light breezes at Perry pleasant  
Dec 1831 at 3 P.M. finished cutting Lake more  
whales to leeward with off two boats  
night came & could not strike  
Middle & latter part wind & weather the same  
Saw many blackfish. So ends Lat 9° 36' Long 88° 13' at 4 P.M.

W 21<sup>st</sup> Begins with strong breezes at S.E. & good weather  
Dec 1831 employed boiling the - Midan & latter part  
light breezes & fine weather stood to the  
S.E. - Saw many blackfish - at 10 P.M.  
finished boiling -  
So ends this day Lat 9° 23' Long 88° 40'

Th 22<sup>nd</sup> Begins with light breezes at S.E. - employed  
Dec 1831 blowing down oil - Middle & latter part  
wind & weather the same at 9 A.M.  
Spoke ship Phoenix of New Bedford &  
a whales - finished blowing down & oil  
So ends this day Lat 9° 10' Longitude Dec 22<sup>nd</sup> 87° 28'

F 23<sup>rd</sup> Begins with light winds and fine weather Middle & latter  
Dec 1831 part the same - employed cleaning the ship -  
Saw blackfish - So ends Lat 9° 00' Long 87° 40'

Sat 24<sup>th</sup> Dec Begins with light winds & Perry pleasant - stood to the  
S.W. - Midan & latter part the same Saw blackfish  
So ends this day Lat 9° 13' Long 88° 25'

Sun 25<sup>th</sup> Dec Begins light winds at S.E. & Perry pleasant  
Midan & latter part the same - Saw humpback  
& Grampases - So ends Lat 10° 18' Long 89° 28'

M 26<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds & Perry pleasant  
Dec 1831 Middle & latter part the same  
at 9 A.M. Saw Sperm whales put off to leeward  
one & upset the boat drove some & c  
So ends no obs Lat 9° 40' Long 89° 50'

Ship Leonidas  
Dec 27<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds & Perry pleasant  
Dec 1831 at 5 P.M. struck & got the same whale  
that drove our boat - Middle & latter  
part wind & weather the same at 10 A.M.  
finished cutting & began to boil - Saw blackfish  
So ends Lat 11° 00' Long by Chronometer 90° 05'

W 28<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds & Perry pleasant  
Dec 1831 Middle & latter part the same - Saw blackfish & war hawks  
at 9 P.M. finished boiling to barrels - many ship yacks seen  
So ends Latitude 10° 56' Long 90° 07' by Chronometer

Th 29<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds at East Perry  
Dec 1831 Pleasant - Midan & latter part the  
same - Saw Blackfish & war hawks  
So ends Lat 10° 48' Long 90° 07' Chronom

F 30<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & c  
Dec 1831 & fine weather stood to the south  
with all sail Middle & latter part wind  
& weather the same - at 6 P.M. carried away  
the gib boom - Latter part got out down one  
So ends this day Lat 11° 14' Long 90° 50' Chr

Sat 31<sup>st</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & c & cloudy  
Dec 1831 weather - Middle & latter part the same  
Saw birds & Blackfish  
So ends this day  
So ends this week  
So ends this year  
one thousand & fifty barrels Sperm oil  
1050

Lat 10° 34' South  
Longitude 89° 30' West by Chronom  
Chronometer to show 36° 58' losing 3 days
