

Coast of Peru: Henry Cleveland
Jan 23rd Begins with light winds & fine weather
Middle & Latter part the same
1832 at 11 A.M. saw breaches off weather bow
So ends this day Lat 10° 53' Long 82° 47' Chr

Jan 24th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & fine
Jan 1832 weather at 2 feet off for sperm whales
at 6 got three alongside
Middle & Latter Strong breezes
at noon finished cutting & made sail
So ends this day Lat 10° 45' Long 82° 47'

Jan 25th Begins with strong breezes at S.E. & saw
Jan 1832 sperm whales to windward
Middle & Latter part light winds & fine
weather Employed boiling 436
So ends this day Lat 11° 04' Long 82° 55' Chr

Jan 26th Begins with light winds & fine weather
Jan 1832 Middle part brisk breezes Latter part
light airs at S.E. Saw blackfish
at 8 A.M. finished boiling Made 45 barrels good
the oil of three, saw whales
So ends this day no 66 Lat 11° 00' Long 82° 50'

Jan 27th Begins with Calm & Cloudy
Jan 1832 Middle & Latter part light winds
Employed blowing down oil
So ends this day Lat 11° 00' Long 83° 00'

Jan 28th Begins with light winds & fine weather
Jan 1832 Middle part Cloudy Latter part light
winds at S.E. Saw finbacks
So ends this day no 66 Lat 11° 30' Long 83° 00'
finished blowing down the oil 15 barrels

Ship Leonidas
Jan 29th Begins with light airs at S.E. and some rain
Jan 1832 Middle & Latter part brisk breezes and fine
weather - Saw nothing remarkable
So ends this day Lat 11° 00' Long 81° 18' Chr

Jan 30th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & fine weather
Jan 1832 Middle & Latter part wind and weather the
same - Saw two Grampuses from the ^{deck} fore
So ends this day Lat 11° 08' Long 80° 25' Chronometer

Jan 31st Begins with strong breezes at South & good weather
Jan 1832 Middle part the same Latter part light
winds & fine pleasant weather Saw many
sperm whales put off to get one
So ends this day Lat 11° 03' Long 79° 45' Chr

Feb 1st Begins with brisk breezes and fine weather
Feb 1832 at 5 P.M. finished cutting the whale
Saw more whales right off and got one
at sunset took him alongside
Middle & Latter part the same Commenced
boiling Latter at 11 A.M. finished cutting
Saw many sperm whales put off & killed one
large whale
So ends this day Lat 10° 42' Long 79° 01' Chronometer

Feb 2nd Begins with light winds and fine weather
Feb 1832 at 3 P.M. got the whale alongside plenty more
in sight got dinner & put off again but
could not strike Latter part cut in the body
of the whale So ends Lat 10° 31' Long 79° 18'

Feb 3rd Begins with brisk breezes and fine weather. Cut in
Feb the head and made sail Middle and latter part
wind & weather the same employed boiling
450 - Saw Blackfish
So ends this day Lat 10° 50' Long 79° 30'
