

Feb 14<sup>th</sup> Coast of Peru. The ship by Henry  
February Begins with calm pleasant & very warm  
1832 all hands employed boiling BC  
Middle part the same. Latter part  
light breezes at S.E. Put in the  
head. So ends this day Lat 11° 10' Long 79° 20'

Feb 15<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds at S.E. & fine  
February weather. Stood to the S.W. Middle part  
1832 at 12 M. N. finished boiling  
Latter part brisk breezes stood in shore  
So ends this day Lat 11° 52' Long 79° 48' Chs

Feb 16<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. &  
February fine weather at 5 P.M. Long 79° 29'  
1832 Middle part by the way. Latter part cleared  
N.W. Employed throwing down bil  
So ends this day Lat 11° 51' Long 79° 29'

Feb 17<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes and fine weather  
February Middle & latter part the same  
1832 finished throwing down made 130 lbs  
So ends. Lat 11° 34' Long 78° 50' Chs

Feb 18<sup>th</sup> Begins with light winds & fine  
February weather all hands employed cleaning  
1832 ship. Several men complaining with  
the scurvy. Middle part the same  
Latter brisk breezes saw blackfish.  
Saw the Brig to leeward  
So ends this day Lat 10° 40' Long 79° 45'

Feb 19<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. and good  
February weather at 7 P.M. spoke ship Independence  
1832 of New Bedford 4 1/2 months out no air Chase  
Middle & latter part light winds  
stood to the S.W. Saw a Carcase  
So ends this day Lat 11° 07' Long 79° 55' Chs

Cleveland Ship Leonidas of Bristol R.I.  
Feb 20<sup>th</sup> Begins with fine weather & light winds  
February Middle and latter part wind and weather  
1832 the same. Saw two brigs -  
So ends this day Lat 10° 49' Long 79° 29' Chs

Feb 21<sup>st</sup> Begins with light winds and fine weather  
Feb at 4 P.M. spoke Brig Minnawan of  
1832 Stonington. Palmer Master.  
Saw him & few Casks -  
Middle & latter part wind and weather the  
same. So ends this day Lat 10° 38' Long 79° 00' Chs

Feb 22<sup>nd</sup> Begins with fine weather and brisk  
February breezes. Employed setting up shooks  
1832 Middle & latter part the same  
So ends this day Lat 11° 10' Long 79° 30' Chs

Feb 23<sup>rd</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. and good  
February weather stood to the S.W.  
1832 Middle part equally with some light rain  
Latter part strong breezes stood in shore  
So ends this day Lat 11° 28' Long 79° 40' Chs

Feb 24<sup>th</sup> Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. and good  
February weather stood in shore. Middle & latter  
1832 part the same. Saw Grampogee  
all hands employed cleaning the ship.  
So ends this day Lat 11° 01' Long 78° 40' Chs

Feb 25<sup>th</sup> Begins with light airs at S.E. and fine  
February weather stood to the S.E.  
1832 Middle and latter light airs from the north  
& Calms - at 6 A.M. saw the land  
So ends this day Lat 10° 00' Long 78° 15' Chs
