

Coast of Peru on board Ship.

Jan 26th Begins with light airs at N.W. and pleasant weather stood to the North. Middle and Latter part Calm. Saw finbacks. So ends this day Lat 10° 11' Long 78° 16' the land 15 miles dist -

Feb 1st 1832 Begins with little or no wind and pleasant weather. Middle and latter part Calm. Saw many Shearwaters. the land 45 miles dist. So ends this day Lat 10° 24' Long 78° 15'

Feb 8th Begins with Calm. - Middle & latter part the same. So ends this day Lat 10° 03' Long 78° 15'

Feb 9th Begins with Calm. - Middle and latter part much the same. Saw many Shearwaters. So ends this day Lat 10° 01' Long 78° 15'

Mar 1st Begins with brisk trades and fine weather. Stood in for the land at 6 P.M. boarded a little vessel from Paita bound to Lima. Middle & latter part stood off to on the Port of Guarmay. at 11 A.M. went in with the boat and landed out the day found good anchorage from 6 to 8 fathoms. Muddy bottom. the S.W. head bearing S.W. the rock or small Islet bearing N.W. So ends this day.

Mar 2nd Begins with strong trades and good weather at 9 A.M. came to anchor. Latter part employed getting of water. So ends this day.

Lat 3rd Begins with brisk trades - - -

March 1832 Middle & latter part Calm. - one half the crew on shore on liberty. So ends this day -

Mar 4th Begins with light winds. - and good weather

March 1832 Middle & latter part the same. So ends this day.

Mar 5th Begins with light trades & good weather. - had the Governor & his suite on board. - Middle part the same. Latter part brisk trade. the brig Annawan left here for Santa. So ends this day Long by Chr 78° 02'

March 6th 1832 Begins with brisk trades and good weather. Middle and latter part the same. 6 of the liberty men not returned at 10 A.M. Returned Silas S. Franklin. & took his downy. also William. Secum returned. - So ends this day.

March 7th 1832 Begins with strong trades and good weather. Middle part Calm. Latter part strong trades. all returned excepting Thomas Roach & Charles Steetter - got off one raft of water & one boat. Steve Perry had Breaker on shore. So ends this day.

March 8th Begins with strong trades & good weather. Middle Calm. - Latter part brisk breezes - at 10 A.M. the Governor brought Thomas & others. good water down paid him. & he took him on board. and got Underway. So ends the Lat of Guarmay is 12° 08' not a very good place.
