March Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & S.
1832 B fine weather stood in shore.
Middle part stood off. Latter part stood
in shore. Saw nothing remarkable
So ends this day Lat 12° 16' Long 77° 50'

Lat 26th Begins with light winds B fine weather
March Middle part strong winds. Latter brisk
1832 breezes B good weather. Saw one fin back
So ends this day Lat 13° 18' Long 78° 15' E.
Green water lies off as far as 78° 05'

Lat 25th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & S.
March Middle & Latter part wind and weather
1832 the same. Saw nothing remarkable.
So ends this day Lat 13° 30' Long 78° 30'
the Copperage coming off.

Lat 26th Begins with brisk winds at South
March stood to the east. Middle and latter
part wind and weather the same
at 6 A.M. Saw the land.
So ends this day Lat 14° 02' Long 76° 50'

Lat 27th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E.
March stood to the S.W. with all sail.
1832 at 3 P.M. spoke ship Robert Edwards
of New Bedford. Howland Master.
120 barrels oil.
Middle and latter part light winds
Saw black fish.
So ends this day Lat 14° 18' Long 75° 15' E.
the green water extends off here to
77° 20' Lat 15° 00'

Lat 28th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & S.
March fine weather stood to the S.W. with
1832 all sail. at 6 P.M. tacked to the east
Middle and latter part strong breezes
Saw nothing remarkable.
So ends this day Lat 14° 50' Long 76° 10'

Lat 29th Begins with strong breezes at S.E.
March and good weather. At 6 P.M. tacked
off shore land in sight a mile off
Saw two hump backs steering to the S.
Middle & latter part wind and weather
the same. Saw fin backs.
So ends this day Lat 15° 46' Long 76° 30'

Lat 30th Begins with strong trades and good
weather stood in shore land in
sight at 6 tacked off at 2 P.M. tacked
in. Strong trades. Saw hump backs
So ends this day Lat 15° 19' Long 72 miles

Lat 31st Begins with brisk trades and good
March weather Middle and latter part much
1832 the same. Saw many hump backs.
So ends this day Lat 15° 40' the land's leagues distant
So ends this day Lat 15° 40'

Lat 1st of April Begins with brisk breezes at S.E. & S.
1832 weather Middle and latter part
light winds stood off shore. Saw nothing
So ends this day Lat 15° 54' Long 74° 10'

Lat 2nd of April Begins with brisk breezes and good weather
April stood to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked to the S.E. & S.
Middle and latter part moderate. Saw many
hump backs near the land.
So ends this day Lat 15° 16' Long 75° 11'
