

Coast of Peru on board ship.

Tue 3rd April 1832 Begins with brisk trades and fine weather. Cleared W. & S. Middle part light winds cleared W. & S. Latter part brisk breezes cleared W. & S. W. Saw Blackfish in the edge of green water. So ends this day Lat 14° 53' Long 76° 56' E. H.

Wed 4th April 1832 Begins with brisk trades and fine weather. Cleared W. & S. W. Middle part the same. Latter part cleared S. W. & W. Saw 2 black fish. So ends this day Lat 14° 09' Long 78° 23' E. H.

Th 5th April 1832 Begins with Moderate breezes at S. E. Is fine weather. Cleared S. W. & W. Middle & Latter part brisk breezes. Saw nothing. So ends this day Lat 13° 02' Long 79° 34' E. H.

Fri 6th April 1832 Begins with light winds Is fine weather. Cleared S. E. Middle and Latter part stood to S. E. Saw nothing remarkable. So ends this day Lat 12° 04' Long 79° 00' E. H.

Sat 7th April 1832 Begins with Moderate breezes and fine weather. Stood to S. E. Middle part stood off 4 hours Is then stood on again. Latter part Moderate at 4 o'clock saw Sperm whales at half past 11 put off two boats. So ends this day Lat 11° 48' Long 78° 24' E. H.

Sun 8th April 1832 Begins with brisk trades at S. E. Struck a large whale to starboard at 2 o'clock. Struck another & killed him at 5 took him alongside. Middle and latter part Strong breezes Is rough at 6 o'clock began to cut the whale. So ends Lat 11° 13' Long 78° 00' E. H. on the outer edge of green water.

Continued the 9th April 1832 Begins with strong winds Is rough weather. Saw Sperm whales to windward going to windward quick. At 5 P.M. got through cutting and bailing the Case at 6 tacked to the westward water green. Commenced boiling. Middle & Latter part Strong breezes Is rough weather at 9 o'clock tacked in shore. So ends this day Lat 11° 00' Long 79° 00' E. H.

Tue 10th April 1832 Begins with Strong Strong breezes Is rough. Stood in shore employed boiling Is Middle part stood off. Latter part stood in shore fine weather at 1 o'clock finished boiling about 40 barrels. Lost 2 monkeys overboard. So ends this day Lat 11° 05' Long 78° 39' E. H.

Wed 11th April 1832 Begins with brisk trades Is fine weather. Middle & Latter part Much the same at 4 P.M. struck the outer edge of water. Lat 11° 00' Long 78° 21' by Chronometer. So ends this day Lat 11° 35' Long 78° 32' E. H.

Th 12th April 1832 Begins with with brisk breezes at S. E. Is good weather. Stowed down the oil 70. Middle part Much the same. Latter part Strong breezes Is rough at 8 o'clock green water. So ends Lat 11° 18' Long 78° 10' E. H.

Fri 13th April 1832 Begins with strong breezes at S. E. Stood off shore. Middle & Latter part Much the same. Saw a large ship standing in shore took it to be a Merchant ship. So ends this day Lat 11° 54' Long 79° 20' E. H.
