

Coast of Peru Ship Lemidan
 Apr. 26th Begins with strong breezes & rough
 April Steared North. Middle part Steared
 1832 N.E. & N.W. Latter part North. Saw blackfish
 So ends this day Lat 9°06 Long 81°43

Apr. 27th Begins with strong breezes at S.E.
 April 26 rough. Steared North. towed twice
 for blackfish. Middle part by too
 strong breezes. Latter part wind
 the same Steared north.
 So ends this day Lat 8°16 Long 81°02

Apr. 28th Begins with strong winds & rough
 April Steared N.E. & S. at 6 P.M. the sea lobs
 1832 Island bearing N.E. & S. Middle by off
 on latter part good weather but smoky
 Steared to the north by the island
 for the main land. Saw one humpback
 So ends this day Lat 6°17 Long 80°53

Apr. 29th Begins with strong breezes at South
 April Steared N.E. & S. Middle part Steared off
 1832 shore under short sail. Latter part
 at anchor in shore. Saw many blackfish
 Caught one
 So ends this day Lat 6°18 Long 81°43

Apr. 30th Begins with strong breezes & rough
 April Steared N.E. & S. land in sight
 1832 Middle part strong winds and rough
 weather headed off shore with main top
 at anchor. Latter part Calm
 So ends this day Lat 5°48 Long 81°20-30
 Night

 May 1st
 1832 Begins with strong breezes at South.
 26 fine weather Steared N.E. & S. for Payta.
 Middle & latter part wind and weather
 the same got to leeward of Payta
 and to beat to windward
 So ends this day

May 2nd
 1832 Begins with strong winds right
 out of the harbour at 6 P.M. came
 too anchor at Payta to Coopers oil
 lying here Ship Friendship Merchant
 26 barque Traballa Albert both off
 Fairhaven & 2 1/2 months out now
 So ends this day - Commenced Coopers
 oil

May 3rd
 May Begins with strong breezes & S.E. breeze
 Middle part the same. Latter part
 moderate employed Coopers
 oil. So ends this day

May 4th
 May 1832 Begins with brisk trades & fine
 weather Middle & latter part moderate
 So ends this day - Coopers oil
 Begins with fine weather & moderate
 Middle & latter part strong trades
 finished Coopers 400 barrels & stowed
 it down. So ends this day

May 6th
 May 1832 Begins with brisk breezes & fine weather
 Middle & latter part light winds
 'Crossed a shore on liberty. So ends
 May 7th
 May Begins with brisk trades at 6 P.M. when
 Returned. Some of them drunk as usual
 Thomas Francis left behind at 8 A.M.
 Returned. Middle & latter part moderate
 So ends this day employed Coopers
 oil
