

Off Shore Coast of Peru
 June 18th Begins with brisk trades
 1832 By fine weather cleared South
 Middle & latter part much the same
 Low finbacks breaching
 So ends this day Lat 2° 5' Long 109° 00'

June 19th Begins with strong breezes at S.E.
 1832 by S.W. Middle & latter part
 fine weather stood to the S.W.
 Saw finbacks porpoises & cut black fish
 So ends this day Lat 3° 43' Long 103° 26'

June 20th Begins with brisk trades & fine weather
 1832 stood to the S.W. Middle & latter
 part much the same. Saw finbacks
 So ends this day Lat 4° 6' Long 106° 30'

June 21st Begins with strong trades & fine
 weather. stood to the S.W.
 Middle part squally stood to the
 South. Latter part brisk breezes
 took us to the North. Spoke Ship
 Lima of San Francisco 12 Months out
 900 barrels Spoke Bark Arab Bunker
 9 months 250 barrels the Arab had
 5 men to take a boat and leave
 the ship in the night hereabouts
 So ends this day Lat 6° 06' Long 105° 15'

June 22nd Begins with strong breezes & thought
 1832 stood to the S.E. Bark Arab & Lima in
 Company. Saw sperm whales put up & got
 one to each ship. Middle & latter part
 light winds. Cut in the whale
 So ends this day Lat 5° 55' Long 105° 30'

Thurs. by Henry Cleveland Ship Conical
 Lat 28° Begins with strong breezes & fine
 June 1832 stood to the S.E. Middle & latter
 part the same employed hauling
 Saw three ships
 So ends this day Lat 5° 42' Long 105° 30'

June 23rd Begins with fine moderate
 weather at 2 P.M. saw sperm
 whales at 3 M. got one & cut
 took him alongside & cut in
 the body. Middle moderate
 latter part strong breezes
 at day light saw sperm whales
 cut in the head & put off & got
 another at 10 A.M. took him alongside
 So ends this day Lat 5° 44' Long 105° 30'

June 24th Begins with strong breezes & squally
 weather. Cut in the whale & made
 sail saw one ship. Middle part
 moderate. Latter part strong breezes
 Saw finbacks - & one ship -
 So ends this day Lat 5° 49' Long 105° 54'

June 25th Begins with strong breezes & fine
 weather employed hauling
 Middle & latter part the same at 4 P.M.
 finished hauling. Saw finbacks & one ship
 So ends this day Lat 5° 02' Long 106° 06'

June 26th Begins with strong winds & good weather
 Middle & latter part almost a gale
 employed hauling out for to blow down
 bit. Saw finbacks
 So ends this day Lat 6° 12' Long 106° 15'
