So ends this day Lat 5-38 Long 106-16

Th. 1st Begins with strong breezes stood to
of July the N.E. saw the Omega get a whale
1832 passed a ship Providence called it
the Liaia of Nantucket.
So ends this day Lat 5-08 Long 106-18

At 2nd Begins with strong breezes at S.E.
July 1832 B. Breezed weather -
Middle & latter part the same
Saw two ships -
So ends this day Lat 5-13 Long 106-12

Th. Henry Cleveland ship Leonician
Th. 3rd Begins with strong rain & squally weather
July 1832 stood to the N.E. Middle & latter part
the same saw many finbacks -
So ends this day Lat 6-54 Long 106-09

Th. 4th Begins with brisk breezes & fine
1832 weather stood to the S.W. at 3 P.M. ship
Omega passed to windward & was
Middle & latter part much the same
Saw two ships to windward saw a whale
So ends this day Lat 5-14 Long 106-20

Th. 5th Begins with brisk breezes at S.E.
Th. good weather - Middle & latter part
moderate saw a ship boiling -
So ends this day Lat 5-22 Long 106-15

Th. 6th Begins with moderate breezes & fine
1832 weather spoke ship Lima 1000 lbs.
Middle & latter part light winds & very
pleasant - saw porpoises & one Carcase
So ends this day Lat 5-28 Long 106-20 Ch.

Lat 4th Begins with light winds & very pleasant
July Middle & latter part the same saw 3 ships
So ends this day Lat 5-10 Long 106-10

Th. 8th Begins with light winds & pleasant
July Middle & latter part the same saw porpoises
So ends this day Lat 5-22 Long 106-19 3 ships in sight

At 9th Begins with brisk breezes & fine weather
July Middle part the same latter part strong
winds saw two ships So ends Lat 6-00 Long 106-10

Th. 10th Begins with strong breezes & good weather - Middle &
latter part strong breezes saw a Carcase
Saw ships No. 6 & Omega -
So ends this day Lat 6-52 Long 105-30
