

Sun 29th July 1832
 Galapagos Islands. Kept by
 Begins with brisk breezes at 8 AM
 fine weather. Steared off round
 the rock. Reached the head of
 the C. E. point of Albamarle
 stood from 8 PM until 1 AM
 then stood to the eastward at daylight
 found ourselves out of sight off the rock
 to the westward. So ends the day
 Lat 25 miles north the rock. South
 of us
 Aug 30th Begins with brisk breezes at 8 AM
 weather. Steared to S. E. Middle
 Latter part light winds to S. E. Strong
 current setting to the S. W.
 So ends the ship between C. E. point
 of Albamarle & Abington Island
 Tue July 31st Begins with light winds & pleasant
 weather. trying hard to get to
 Frances Island for turpentine
 Middle & Latter part strong winds
 beat to windward with all sail. Lost 2 miles
 So ends this day Lat 4 8 Long 91
 Wed Aug 1st Begins with strong winds at 8 AM. stood to the
 eastward. Middle and latter part the
 same. Caught one porpoise
 So ends this day Lat 1 10 Long 90 65
 Thu August 2nd 1832 Begins with brisk breezes at 8 AM. fine
 weather. Spoke ship began
 Middle & latter part used weather the
 same. saw humpbacks porpoises & 2
 So ends this day Lat 1 21 Long 88 50
 Fri August 3rd 1832 Begins with brisk breezes at 8 AM. stood to the
 eastward. Middle and latter part the
 same. So ends this day Lat 1 01 Long
 Long 86 50. P.M.

Henry Cleveland Ship Leonidas
 Sat 4th August Begins with brisk breezes at 8 AM
 fine weather. stood to the eastward
 with all sail. Middle & Latter part the
 same. So ends this day Lat 20 12 Long 85 34
 Sun 5th August Begins with brisk winds at 8 AM
 fine weather. Steared to S. E.
 Middle & Latter part some fog
 So ends this day Lat 20 37 Long 84 25
 Mon 6th August All this 24 hours Moderate breezes &
 fine pleasant weather. saw nothing of note
 So ends this day Lat 1 06 Long 83 07 P.M.
 Tue 7th August All this 24 hours Moderate breezes
 and fine weather at 8 AM saw
 a school of sperm whales fit off all
 the boats. struck 3 & saved one
 So ends this day Lat 1 25 Long 82 00
 Wed 8th August All these 24 hours Moderate breezes
 with fog fine rain & Sunshine
 Cut in the whale & boiled it out made
 So ends this day Lat 2 19 Long 81 50 P.M.
 Thu 9th August All this day brisk breezes & fog squalls
 saw many humpbacks at 4 AM.
 saw point of St. Helena. bearing N. E.
 saw the breakers on the low land to windward
 of it which we took for whales breaching
 So ends this day Lat 2 40 Long 81 03
 Fri 10th August this day begins with brisk breezes at 8 AM
 fine weather. Steared to S. E. Middle
 part headed off shore under short sail
 Latter steared N. E. by 7 PM. plates
 to 4 AM. saw it bearing N. E. saw many hump
 So ends this day Lat 1 03 Long 81 15
 Sat 11th August All these 24 hours brisk breezes with
 some clear weather. fog squalls
 bent the cables & stood in for Salango
 So ends this day Lat 1 35 Long 80 15
 bearing N. E. in sight
