

Knave of Peru kept by Henry
M. Oct 8th 1832

All this day moderate breezes & fine weather stood to the N. E. at 6 o'clock
Saw a large school of whales right off all the boats struck one large & one small whale lost the small one with a line - killed the large one: at 10 took him alongside & began to cut -
So ends this day Lat 8th 30 Long 86th 00

Thu 9th Begins with light winds and fine weather
Oct 8th P.M. finished cutting. Saw two schools of whales at great distance off while cutting and began to hail middle and latter part with weather the same

at 6 o'clock saw one large whale right off & got him at 9 took him alongside
So ends this day Lat 7th 55 Long 86th 30

W 10th Oct All this day moderate breezes and fine weather at 10 M. saw a whale near the ship - cut in the whale & C

So ends this day Lat 7th 48 Long 86th 00

Th 11th Oct Begins with fine weather - middle part squally - latter part fine weather

Saw one ship to leeward saw blackfish
So ends this day Lat 7th 33 Long 85th 30

F 12th Oct All this day brisk breezes and good weather at 8 P.M. finished boiling. Saw two ships -

So ends this day Lat 8th 05 Long 86th 00

Sat 13th Oct All this day fine weather. Spoke bark Equator of A. Bedford 1200 Bark Isabella 300

latter part employed blowing down air
So ends this day Lat 8th 31 Long 86th 30

Cleveland Ship Leonidas
Sun 14th Oct 1832

All this day brisk breezes & good weather at 7 P.M. tacked to the S. E. at 6 o'clock
Saw bark Isabella -
So ends this day Lat 8th 8 Long 86th 25

M 15th Oct All this day brisk breezes & good weather finished blowing down & cleaned off

Saw finbacks & blackfish -
So ends this day no cut Lat 8th 20 Long 85th 20
Got out Shegar

Th 16th Oct All this day fine pleasant weather

Saw nothing remarkable
Lat 8th 11 Longitude 85th 30

W 17th Oct 1832 All this day moderate breezes and very pleasant weather - stood to the southward - at 11 o'clock saw a large sperm whale down boats & struck him

So ends this day Lat 8th 59 Long 86th 10

Th 18th Oct 1832 Begins with the best of weather at 2 P.M. took up the Stoven boat and got out ^{the} boat

at 4 P.M. got the whale dead at took him alongside - at 6 o'clock began to cut at 11 finished cutting the body
So ends this day Lat 8th 52 Long 86th 36

F 19th Oct Begins with fine weather at 3 P.M. finished cutting. at 5 began to boil

Middle & latter part weather the same
So ends this day Lat 8th 50 Long 86th 20

Sat 20th Oct All this day light winds & fine weather

Saw many blackfish & finbacks at 9 o'clock finished boiling
So ends this day Lat 9th 04 Long 87th 05
