

Nov 6th 1832
 Coast of Peru. Left by Henry
 All this day strong winds & rough
 sea. Nothing remarkable -
 So ends this day Lat 8°55' Long 87°40'

Nov 7th
 All this day strong winds. Stood to the
 N.E. employed blowing down 6 P.M.
 So ends this day Lat 8°24' Long 87°30'

Nov 8th
 All this day strong winds & rough
 weather. finished blowing down 7 P.M.
 at 10 P.M. saw a sperm whale chased
 6 hours with the boats & left him.
 So ends this day Lat 7°54' Long 87°00' 86°30'

Nov 9th
 All this day brisk breezes and good weather
 at 6 A.M. saw two sperm whales put
 off two boats & chased 5 hours to windward
 at 11 saw another to leeward very low
 he perceived the boats & went off
 So ends this day Lat 7°47' Long 86°10'

Nov 10th
 All this day brisk breezes & good
 weather. Saw nothing remarkable
 So ends this day Lat 7°37' Long 85°50'

Sunday
 11th November 1832
 All this day brisk winds & good weather
 Saw nothing remarkable
 So ends this day Lat 8°24' Long 85°10'

Nov 12th
 All this day brisk breezes & fine
 weather. Saw finbacks & blackfish.
 So ends this day Lat 7°40' Long 86°20'

Nov 13th
 All this day brisk breezes & good
 weather. Saw nothing remarkable
 So ends this day Lat 8°39' Long 87°10'

Cleveland Ship Leonard Bristol P.M.
 Nov 14th 1832
 Begins with brisk breezes at
 1 P.M. good weather. Spoke ship
 Logan of New Bedford 25 M's 1400
 Middle & latter part wind and
 weather the same
 So ends this day Lat 9°32' Long 87°40'

Nov 15th
 Begins with strong winds and
 rough weather at 2 P.M. saw
 a sperm whale near the ship
 put off two boats. Saw no more of
 him - Spoke ship Logan again
 Middle and latter part wind & weather
 the same. So ends the day
 Lat 9°45' Long 87°10'

Nov 16th
 All this day brisk breezes & good
 weather. Ship Logan in sight off
 sea quarter. So ends this day
 Lat 10°15' Long 88°22'

Nov 17th
 All this day brisk breezes & fine
 weather. Stood to the N.W. with all
 sail at 10 P.M. spoke ship Logan
 standing to the N.E. So ends this day
 Lat 11°18' Long 89°45'

Sunday 18th
 November
 First part brisk breezes - at 6 P.M. stood
 to the N.E. Middle & latter part light
 winds - saw 6 boobys - So ends this day
 Lat 11°09' Long 89°25'

Nov 19th
 All this day light winds & cloudy
 weather. Stood to the N.E. at 2 P.M.
 saw 3 or 4 sperm whales put off to one
 he was a humpback whale. So ends this day
 Lat 10°26' Long 88°65'

Nov 20th
 All this day light winds & a fine pleasant
 weather at 6 P.M. finished cutting
 the whale at 8 commenced boiling
 So made sail. So ends at 2 P.M. saw a
 sperm whale supposed he went to windward
 Lat 10°00' Long 88°50'
