

Coast of Peru kept by Henry Cleve
Sunday 6th All this day brisk breezes & fine weather
January 1833 Saw blackfish. So ends this day till 9th Long 84-15.

Mon 7th All this day brisk breezes & cloudy weather
Long 83-20 Stood to the S.E. saw blackfish. So ends

Tue 8th Begins with brisk breezes & cloudy weather
at 3 P.M. saw a sperm whale
at 5 darted at him and off he went to
windward. Middle and latter part wind
& weather the same saw blackfish.
Blowed down 6 barrels of oil. So ends this day
water green

Wed 9th All this day brisk breezes & fine weather
Long 83-20 Stood to the S.E. by the wind. So ends this day
water green

Thu 10th All this day light winds & fine weather
Long 83-20 Stood to the eastward with all sail -
Saw nothing remarkable. So ends this day

Fri 11th All this day light winds & Calms
at 10 o'clock spoke Ship ^{Antilla} of London
Long 80-00 Brooks master 5 months out 100 bbls.
So ends this day

Sat 12th All this day light winds & Calms
Long 80-00 fitting boatsprit rigging saw one small blackfish.
So ends this day

Sunday 13th All this day light winds & Calms. Saw a brig
January 1833 So ends this day
Long 80-00

Mon 14th All this day brisk breezes & fine weather
Long 79-30 Saw blackfish porpoises fin & hump back
So ends this day

on board Ship Leonias at Bristol the Islander
Tue 15th All this day Calms light winds & fog at 9 o'clock
1833 Saw the post of Santa Theresa this day Long 80-00

Wed 16th Begins with light winds & some fog - went in
at 9 o'clock with a boat to sound the harbour
Long 79-00 if it can be called such. Consider it
not suitable to anchor a large vessel
and leave it as fast as possible.
Middle part Calms. Latter part light
winds. Spoke Ship Mount Vernon
of San Francisco. Captain Master & Monte
port no oil.

Thu 17th All this day light winds & fine weather
at 9 o'clock to the S.W. with all sail - Saw blackfish
Long 79-00 and sinkers. So ends this day

Fri 18th All this day moderate breezes & fine weather
Long 79-00 Stood on different tracks the way we
get S.E. Most. Latter part land in sight
Saw blackfish. water blue. So ends this day

Sat 19th All this day light winds & fine weather
Long 78-30 Stood in shore. Saw nothing remarkable
Long 78-30 So ends this day. Land 13 miles east.

Sun 20th All this day light winds & Calms
Long 78-30 Saw nothing remarkable. So ends

Mon 21st All this day light winds & fog in the
Long 78-30 morning. Saw a brig. So ends this day

Tue 22nd Begins with brisk breezes and good
weather at 5 P.M. came to anchor at
Guamney in 7 fathoms water. Winds &
latter part the same. So ends this day.
Starboard wash on shore on liberty.
