

Off Cape Horn. Theft by Henry Chudans  
1833 Begins with brisk gales at West &  
1833 Squally weather. Cleared S.E. & S. with  
Lat 35.14 Double reefed Topsails  
Long 86.13 Middle & latter part more moderate  
by Chr. 35.50 wind at S.W. Bent to Low Foretopsail  
ends this day

Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> May 1833 Begins with strong winds at South  
Squally at 2 P.M. backed to the westward  
Lat 35.46 Middle and latter part the same  
Long 88.48 Flood to the westward with double reefed  
by Chr. 38.45 Topsails. ends this day

Mon 6<sup>th</sup> May Begins with brisk gales at South  
Lat 46.25 from 4 to 8 nearly Calm the first part  
Long 87.29 of this British gales at N.W. cleared S.E.  
ends this day with flights of rain

Tue 7<sup>th</sup> May Begins with brisk gales at N.W. & Cloudy  
No 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 49.15 weather cleared by 8 Under Single reefed  
Long 87.41 Topsails. Middle & latter part strong wind  
at North & rain. ends this day

Wed 8<sup>th</sup> May Begins with strong gales at S.E. & S. some  
Lat 35.22 Rain cleared S.E. with single reefed  
Long 87.34 Topsails. Middle part the same  
Chr. 27.57 latter part wind at S.E. & S. good weather  
cleared S.E. -  
at 3 P.M. saw a sperm whale. ends

Thu 9<sup>th</sup> May Begins with brisk gales at S.E. & S. and good  
Lat 33.50 weather cleared S.E. -  
Long 88.34 Middle & latter part strong winds at East  
and Cloudy  
ends this day. A sail in sight to  
windward

Ship Lomas of Portland Mass  
1833 10<sup>th</sup> May 1833 At 10 this day brisk breezes from East  
No 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 33.26 to S.E. & S. & Cloudy weather. Flood to  
Long 87.54 Southward Under double reefed Topsails  
ends this day. Ship in sight to windward

Lat 11<sup>th</sup> May 1833 At 11 this day brisk breezes from East to S.E.  
No 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 35.51 to S.W. day weather Flood to the Southward  
Long 88.49 Under double reefed topsails. ends this day  
Ship in sight to windward

Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May 1833 First part brisk breezes at S.E. & S.  
No 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 40.02 Flood to the Southward. Middle &  
Long 89.11 latter part Calm. Saw Blackish  
Ship in sight bearing S.E. ends  
Lat of Main & Mizen & Topgallant yards

Mon 13<sup>th</sup> May Begins with light breezes at S.W. & S.  
Lat 51.07 Cloudy weather cleared S.E. & S. with  
Long 85.58 Topgallant sails & topmast studding sail set  
Chr. 85.56 Middle & latter part brisk breezes at S.W.  
light signals of rain. Ship in sight  
to the S.W. ends this day

at 9 A.M. saw two sperm whales going south to S.W.  
Tue 14<sup>th</sup> May Begins with brisk gales at West and  
No 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 54.05 light squalls of rain. Middle & latter  
Long 82.56 part light winds. ends this day

Wed 15<sup>th</sup> May Begins with being light winds at West & Cloudy  
Lat 51.51 cleared S.E. & S. Middle part Calm. Latter  
Long 81.56 part light breezes at S.E. & S. Flood to the S.E.  
ends this day

Thu 16<sup>th</sup> May Begins with light winds at S.E. & S. and to the S.E.  
No 6<sup>th</sup> Lat 50.29 Middle & latter part more moderate with fog  
Long 80.01 fine rain. ends this day
