 1st May 1853 Lat 58-25 Long 78-19
 First part fresh & clear at N.E. & S.E. Under double reefed top sails. Sent down Mizzen top gallant
 Middle part Very Moderate with rain
 Latter part light breezes at West to fine weather. Sent up Mizzen top gallant yard
 & set all sail. Ends this day
 Lat 18 May Lat 58-35 Long 78-44
 First & Middle part brisk gales at N.W. Cleared N.E. Latter part strong winds at N.E. & S.E. Cleared to the N.W.
 Sent down Mizzen top gallant yard
 Ends this day. A ship in sight.
 Sunday 9th May 1853 Lat 59-10 Long 75-23
 Began with strong gales at N.N.E. & S. High rainy weather by 4 P.M. Under double reefed top sails. at 8 took in fore & Mizzen top sail. Close before the main & wore ship wind N.E. at 10 P.M. Middle part the same at 8 P.M. let the top sails & wore ship wind North by East. Ends this day
 10th May Lat 59-10 Long 75-23
 Began with strong winds at N.N.E. & S. Under double reefed top sails. Middle part strong gales at N.E. wore ship & flood taken in. Latter part hard gale at N.W. and S.W. Sea hoisted N.E. Ends this day
 21st May Lat 58-15 Long 71-59
 First part strong gales at N.N.W. & S.W. Middle part brisk gales at N.N.W. with rain. Latter part hard gales at N.W. Cleared N.E. Under double reefed fore & main top sail & fore sail. Ends this day. hard weather

Change in Shore Ship Services of Bristol & S. W. 22 May 1853 Lat 57-42 Long 69-00
 Began with hard gales at N.W. Cleared N.E. with double reefed fore & main top sail
 Bore sail Mizzen part hard gales at N.W. Latter part brisk breezes at N.W. Ends this day
 23rd May Lat 56-52 Long 68-48
 Began with strong gales at N.W. Cleared N.E. with double reefed top sails. Middle & Latter part hard gales at West some squalls of rain at 9 P.M. the sea became smooth suddenly supposed that we passed an island of Ice - at 9 P.M. passed within two miles off an island of Ice about as high as the ships tops above water. Ends this day
 24th May Lat 56-36 Long 68-27
 Began with strong breezes at West and foggy weather. Cleared N.N.E. with double reefed top sails. Middle part wind at North. Latter part hard gale at N.W. & S.W. Clear look in the fore top sail & sent down main top gallant yard. Ends this day
 26th May Lat 56-36 Long 68-26
 Began with hard gales at N.W. Cleared N.E. with double reefed top sails. Middle part more moderate. Latter part calm with some rain. found one of the fore channels had worked up employed securing it &c. Ends this day
 Sunday 26 May Lat 56-36 Long 56-30
 Began with light airs at North with rain. Cleared N.N.E. Middle part hard gales at West with squalls of rain. Latter part strong gales at N.W. Ends this day
