 Sunday 9th June 1833 All this day wind from West to S.W.
 Lat 35-16 Clear N.E. First part strong gales
 Long 42-03 H. squalls of rain. Middle part
 Strong winds & clear weather -
 Latter part light breezes & fine weather -
 So ends this day - - -

Mon 10th June
 Lat 35-06 First part Calm. Middle part strong
 Long 41-13 winds from the North with some rain
 Latter part hard squalls from North to
 N.W. took in the fore topsail -
 double reefed the main - So ends this day

Tue 11th June
 Lat 34-06 Begins with hard gales from N.W. to West
 Long 38-49 H. a very large sea. Middle part
 Very hard gales at 9 P.M. hoist the ship
 too Under storm sails -
 Latter more moderate cleared N.E.
 Lost Starboard hullworks - So ends

Wed 12th June
 Lat 32-56 Begins with strong gales at S.W. to N.W.
 Long 37-27 H. squalls of rain. cleared N.E. with
 Double reefed topsails & foresail -
 Middle part moderate breezes
 Latter part calm - So ends this day

Thu 13th June
 Lat 32-41 All this day wind from the North & fine
 Long 35-38 weather stood to the eastward -
 Lat 36-08 So ends this day

Fri 14th June
 Lat 31-52 All this day strong winds from North
 Long 33-51 to N.W. H. some rain. stood to the
 N.E. with double reefed topsails
 So ends this day

Ship Leonidas Coast of Brazil
 Sat 15th June
 Lat 30-39 H. much rain. cleared N.E.
 Long 32-50 Middle H. latter part light breezes
 Lat 34-10 from N.W. to S.E. fine pleasant
 weather cleared N.E. to S. So ends

Sunday 16th June
 Lat 28-16 All this day brisk breezes & fine weather
 Long 33-15 First part wind E.N. Middle part
 Lat 31-20 N.E. Latter part North
 Lat 31-20 So ends this day

Mon 17th June
 Lat 28-25 All this day brisk breezes at N.W. to S.W.
 Long 31-08 fine weather stood to the N.E.
 Lat 31-26 with whole topsails - - -
 Employed mending a boat. Sailed
 Bonaire Commence - - -

Tue 18th June
 Lat 28-45 All this day brisk breezes at North
 Long 29-10 and fine weather stood to the eastward
 Lat 29-10 with all sail - So ends this day

Wed 19th June
 Lat 27-32 All this day brisk breezes from the North
 Long 27-28 to fine weather stood to the eastward with
 Lat 29-15 all sail. Saw nothing remarkable
 Employed fitting rigging &c. So ends

Thu 20th June
 Lat 26-21 All this day brisk breezes at N.W. to fine
 Long 26-18 weather stood to the N.E. with all sail
 Lat 27-05 one hard squall in the middle watch
 but short - - - So ends this day

Fri 21st June
 Lat 25-25 Mending hullworks & making rigging
 Long 25-25 All this day brisk breezes from North
 Lat 26-30 to N.W. to fine weather stood to the N.E.
 Lat 26-30 Saw a sail at 6 P.M. So ends this day

Sat 22nd June
 Lat 24-30 All this day brisk breezes from the North
 Long 24-30 to good weather stood to the westward & home
 So ends this
