First part of this 24 hours Moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. saw the Land stood in untill 6 P.M. And tacked off to the S.W. Middle and Latter parts the same saw a School of Blackfish and a number of Sunfish. the Carpenter and others employed mending the Boat and doing other necessary things So Ends At 10 A.M. saw a boat to the S.W. and saw Lat by Ob 19-36 for it untill noon

Remarks on Board Sunday th 3

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. And pleasant weather steering S.W. untill 6 P.M. then kept of S.E. and took in the Fore and Mizzen Top Gellantail and halled down the Jib and Fore Top Maststayrail Middle part the same Latter part the wind very little steering S.W. saw Blackfish So Ends

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. steering S.W. saw one Finback Middle part Cloudy the wind at S.E. steering S.W. Latter part little winds at S.E. steering S.W. all hands employed in Painting the Ship and Sheathing the Decks and other necessary jobs So Ends

First part of this 24 hours little breezes at S.E. steering S.W. saw a great number of Finbacks at 6 P.M. took in the Top Gellantails and Braced the Yards and steered S.W. untill 6 A.M. the squared the Yards and steered S.W. at 11 A.M. saw a number sperm whales all hands employed Coopering and setting our Oil down betwixt Decks at 12 hoared all three Boats So Ends in Chase Land 7 Leagues of

First part of this 24 hours a great number of whales in sight all three in Chase the whales very wild At 6 P.M. came on Board and made all sail in hopes to over take them stood off by the wind untill 2 A.M. then tacked in untill noon the wind S.E. tacked Ship And lay the Mainyard A back a small sloop standing out from the land towards us So Ends Land 3 Leagues of

First part of this 24 hours little breezes at S.E. and pleasant at 1 P.M. spoke the Sloop Lussanna Ann of London on a Sealing Voyage. A number of Finbacks in sight Middle and Latter the weather the same at 10 A.M. saw a School of sperm whales hoared and struck one and killed him and took him A long side and got ready for Cutting So Ends
