

Remarks on Board Friday Aprth 29 - 1831

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather one half the crew on shore and the remainder employed Painting and Cleaning and other necessary Duty So Ends
Mantou very unwell the Doctor came on Board to see him

Remarks on Board Saturday Aprth 30

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 6 AM the Boat came from the shore with the Liberty men and they all went quietly below at 9 AM William Barnham was missing together with one of the ships Boys supposed to have swam a way at 2 AM two Boats went down to Coolong after Potatoes the remainder of them on Board employed in Ships Duty So Ends

Remarks on Board Sunday May 1st

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 3 PM the Boats came from Coolong with eight Cargoes of Potatoes and A few Cans of Muddle and Latter the wind and weather the same one Watch on Shore at 8 AM the Ship Michael left the Harbour So Ends
Mantou no better and William Barnham not to be found

Remarks on Board Monday Aprth 2

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather one half on shore on Liberty and the remainder employed in Ships Duty So Ends one Ship in sight of the mouth of the Harbour A news from William Barnham and one brought A Steward from the Ship Timoleon Capt Clark by the name of John Francis

Remarks on Board Tuesday Aprth 3

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather one half of the crew on shore on out of the Ship Averick Muddle and Latter part the wind and weather the same Lariderson Mantou being very Sick and growing worse we take him on Shore and leave him under the Care of Doctor Wendell with suitable Provision for his Support while under his Care So Ends

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 4th - 1831

All this 24 hours fresh breezes and Cloudy one watch on shore on Liberty and the rest employed in Ships Duty at 5 AM one Boat went down to Coolong after Potatoes So Ends

Remarks on Board Thursday Aprth 5

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and Cloudy at 2 PM the arrived from Coolong with 10 Cargoes of Potatoes Muddle and Latter part more moderate set up the rigging and got ready for use So Ends

Remarks on Board Friday Aprth 6

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and pleasant weather at 5 PM weighed Anchor and stood out of the wind under short sail at 6 got the Anchor on the Bore and unhooked the Cable set the Main sail and Fore sail Muddle and Latter part moderate breezes at 8 PM steering West. stowed the Anchor and Chain away and got ready for weighing So Ends three men unwell

Remarks on Board Saturday Aprth 7

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at 8 AM and pleasant weather steering SW saw Timbuck and Blackfish at 6 PM took in the Top Gallantsails and hauled up the Fore sail steered SW Muddle the same Latter part at 6 AM made sail and steered SW the water Green and thick the sick is better So Ends

Lat by Ob 9-55

Remarks on Board Sunday Aprth 8

All this 24 hours moderate breezes and pleasant weather steering SW at 6 PM shortened sail at 6 AM made sail again at 11 AM saw a Ship having 80 So Ends with Ships Duty
