

Remarks on Board Monday May th 9 - 1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E and Cloudy at 2 P M spoke the Ship Wanslow Capt Coffin with 100 Middle part lite breezes lay too with the main yard aback Latter part fresh breezes at 6 A M made sail and steered North saw Blackfish

Remarks on Board Tuesday th 10

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes and Cloudy steering by the wind S E E saw Blackfish at 6 P M shortened sail Middle part the wind lite at 10 P M wore Ship at 2 A M wore back again Latter part fresh breezes at S E steering by the wind E by S saw a Breach to windward So Ends

Remarks on Board Wednesday th 11

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S E steering East at 6 P M shortened sail Middle more moderate at 10 P M wore ship to the S W at 2 A M wore back again Latter part fresh breezes at S E steering by the wind to the S E by E saw Carpuis

Remarks on Board Thursday th 12

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S by W steering by the wind to the S E by E at 2 P M saw a Ship to the leeward maneuvering for whale and we were off for him but saw nothing at 6 P M shortened sail and let the Ship come to the wind Middle part moderate S at 9 wore Ship of show at 6 A M wore back again Latter part fresh breezes and Cloudy at 10 A M too sail in sight a Ship and a Brig at 11 saw the Land Isla de la Plata bearing S E Distance 20 miles At Noon steering S E

Remarks on Board Friday May th 13 - 1831

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at S W steering S E at 3 P M saw a school of whales leaved our Boats struck too and the Irons down and we lost them both came on Board and shortened sail and lay of and on for the night Middle part more moderate Latter part the same at 6 A M made sail at 10 spoke the Ship Logan Capt Fisher with three hundred barrels one other Ship in sight at 10 wore Ship and stood in shore saw Carpuis So Ends

Remarks on Board Saturday th 14

First part of this 24 hours fresh breezes at South at 3 saw the Land and steering East at 6 shortened sail and wore Ship of show Middle and Latter part lite breezes and pleasant at 2 A M wore Ship and stood in at 6 made sail one Ship in sight the Land 10 Leagues Distant

Remarks on Board Sunday th 15

First part of this 24 hours moderate breezes at S by W steering S E until 2 P M then luffed by the wind to the W by S one Ship in sight at 8 P M spoke the Ship Ontario Capt Coffin with 1850 barrels of sperm Oil Middle and Latter part the wind the same and the weather very good at 6 A M made sail and wore Ship to the Eastward the Ontario in sight So Ends

Lat by Ob 00-25

Remarks on Board Monday th 16

All this 24 hours moderate breezes at S S W stood by the wind to the Eastward until 6 P M then tacked to the Westward and took in the Top Gallant sails at 6 A M set them again saw Blackfish So Ends
